

**OCEANIC TIME WARNER CABLE'S MAUI COUNTY AND
LAHAINA/WEST MAUI FRANCHISES RENEWAL PROCESS
(AUGUST 2, 2013 UPDATE)**

On June 2, 2011, Oceanic Time Warner Cable LLC. ("Oceanic") notified the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs ("DCCA"), of its intent to seek renewal of its Maui County and Lahaina/West Maui franchises for cable television service. Both franchise terms expire on December 31, 2013.

After receiving Oceanic's notification, DCCA began planning and developing, with the assistance of its financial consultant, an overall work plan and timeline of activities.

The following is an update to DCCA's anticipated timeline of activities for the rest of the renewal process:

<u>Anticipated Dates in 2013</u>	<u>Activity</u>
May through August	Oceanic and all interested parties are given the opportunity to review the Community Ascertainment and Related Activities Report.
August	Oceanic to submit its application, including comments to issues raised in the Community Ascertainment and Related Activities Report.
August and September	DCCA to review Oceanic's application.
September or October	Public Hearings to be held in Maui County to allow the public to comment on Oceanic's application.
September to December	Discussions and negotiations with Oceanic on franchise terms.
December	Final DCCA's decision on Oceanic's application for renewal of its Maui franchises.

DCCA will seek and carefully consider the community's input on this matter. As noted above, public hearings will be held to afford the public an opportunity to provide testimony and comments on Oceanic's renewal proposal application. Once the public hearings are scheduled, notice will be published in the Maui newspaper and on DCCA Cable Television Division's website.
