

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

APPLICATION OF HAWAIIAN ELECTRIC COMPANY, INC.
FOR APPROVAL TO CONSTRUCT AN OVERHEAD SUBTRANSMISSION LINE

The STATE OF HAWAII PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION ("commission"), pursuant to Hawaii Revised Statutes §§ 269-27.5 and 269-27.6(a), HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that it will hold a public hearing relating to the Application of Hawaiian Electric Company, Inc. ("HECO"), filed on February 19, 2015, for commission approval to extend an overhead 46 kilovolt ("kV") subtransmission line (the "Project") near Waioni Street in the Mililani area of Oahu. The public hearing will be held as follows:

The Project was initiated at the request of Waihonu North LLC in order to accommodate the development and installation of a Tier 3 Feed-In Tariff 5 megawatt ("MW") solar farm on real property owned by Religious Corporation Honbushin and situated in Mililani on the island of Oahu. The existing 46 kV overhead line will be extended into property owned by Religious Corporation Honbushin, where it will connect to a substation for the solar farm. The overhead extension work consists of the installation of: (1) one 65-foot wood pole; (2) one 46 kV pole mounted switch; and (3) approximately 100 circuit feet of 46 kV 336 KCM AAAC overhead conductors. The estimated cost of the Project is \$87,036, plus an estimated interconnection cost of approximately \$2,600,862, both of which will be paid for by Waihonu North LLC.
