NOTICE OF HEARING

Pursuant to Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") section 431:10C-410 and section 91-9.5, notice is hereby given that the Insurance Division ("Division") will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, January 14, 2014, at 9:30 a.m. in the Queen Kapiolani Conference Room, 2nd Floor, King Kalakaua Building, Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs, 335 Merchant Street, Honolulu, Hawaii 96813, to hear all persons interested in AIPSO Filing No. HI 13-01 which was submitted by AIPSO to the Division on behalf of the Hawai'i Joint Underwriting Plan ("HJUP").

The purpose of AIPSO's revenue-neutral filing is to introduce physical damage rates for 2014 through 2015 model year vehicles in accordance with the approved Model Year Rating Program. Also, the base model year is being shifted from 2011 to 2013 for all model year vehicles, i.e., 1990 through 2015. Due to the shift in base model year, the following off-balance

factors are applied to the latest available model year and symbol (Model Year 2013, Symbol 3) so that the revised rates are being introduced on-balance.

Comprehensive: 0.997
Collision: 1.028

The proposed effective date for both new and renewal business is the first day of the second month following the date of approval.

All interested persons shall be afforded the opportunity to submit data, views, or arguments, orally or in writing, to the Insurance Division at the time of hearing. All written and oral submissions regarding the proposed filing shall be fully considered. All persons wishing to submit written testimony are requested to submit, by Thursday, January 9, 2014, a hard copy to the Insurance Division at the address noted below, or an electronic copy to its email address: insurance@dcca.hawaii.gov.

A copy of the proposed filing will be mailed to any interested person who requests a copy and pays the Insurance Division's required fee of \$6.00 for the copy and postage. Please submit your request to the Insurance Division at the address noted below or contact the Division's Office Services Branch via telephone at (808) 586-2790.

A copy of the proposed filing may be obtained before the date of the hearing between 7:45 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding holidays, at the following address: Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs, Insurance Division, 335 Merchant Street, Room 213, Honolulu, Hawaii 96813. The \$6.00 charge will be due and payable at the time of picking up the proposed filing.
