IMPORTANT NOTE:

DUE DATE:

August 16th, or the next business day if the 16th falls on a weekend or holiday.

EXTENSION NOTICE:

A post card, with instructions, will be mailed in June as the one and only notice of certificate of authority extension. The online portal will also be opened in June. For online portal, go to:

PAYMENTS:

We encourage online payments by Credit Card or Electronic Check.

- Go to the Online Portal. Enter your License Number and go to the screen that shows your Company Name and the Subtotal amount due.
- Update email, mailing and business addresses for any changes.
- If paying by Paper Check, simply print the payment screen and use it as your remittance form along with your check.
- Note: Hawaii Joint Underwriting Plan (HJUP) fee applies only to companies with VEHICLE authority.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- 1. IF PAYING BY CHECK:
 - Submit a separate check for each company.
 - Our office must <u>receive</u> the payments and required remittance forms no later than the close of business on <u>August 16th</u> or the next business day if August 16th falls on a weekend or holiday.

2. PENALTIES & CANCELLATION:

A mandatory penalty fee of 50% of the extension fee will be charged if we do not receive the payments (including HJUP fees, if applied), along with required forms and/or documentation, on or before <u>August 16</u>. If the fees and penalties are not received on or before <u>September 16</u>, your Certificate of Authority may be suspended or revoked.

3. RECEIPTS:

We will not return a validated form. Keep your cancelled check or credit card statement as proof of payment. Online payers should be able to print a receipt page when payment is made.

To verify if your Certificate of Authority has been extended, go to the <u>Renew</u> Insurance License section of the Hawaii Insurance Division's website at

The expiration date should be advanced one year from the current August 16th due date.
