**NOTICE OF HEARING**

Pursuant to Hawaii Revised Statutes (“HRS”) section 431:10C-410 and section 91-9.5, notice is hereby given that the Insurance Division (“Division”) will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, December 2, 2014, at 9:30 a.m. in the Queen Kapiolani Conference Room, 2nd Floor, King Kalakaua Building, Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs, 335 Merchant Street, Honolulu, Hawaii 96813, to hear all persons interested in AIPSO Filing No. HI IRS 4242 which was submitted by AIPSO to the Division on behalf of the Hawai’i Joint Underwriting Plan (“HJUP”).

On behalf of the HJUP, AIPSO submitted an individual risk filing to provide \$100,000 property damage liability coverage for an auto used in diplomatic consulate business. AIPSO is

proposing a factor of 1.12 be applied to the appropriate \$10,000 property damage liability rate. This factor was developed by extending the table in HIB's commercial auto filing 2013-03.

The proposed effective date is on approval.

All interested persons shall be afforded the opportunity to submit data, views, or arguments, orally or in writing, to the Insurance Division at the time of hearing. All written and oral submissions regarding the proposed filing shall be fully considered. All persons wishing to submit written testimony are requested to submit, by November 26, 2014, a hard copy to the Insurance Division at the address noted below, or an electronic copy to its email address: [insrpa@dcca.hawaii.gov](mailto:insrpa@dcca.hawaii.gov).

A copy of the proposed filing will be mailed to any interested person who requests a copy and pays the Insurance Division's required fee of \$1.74 for the copy and postage. Please submit your request to the Insurance Division at the address noted below or contact the Division's Office Services Branch via telephone at (808) 586-2790.


A copy of the proposed filing may be obtained before the date of the hearing between 7:45 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding holidays, at the following address: Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs, Insurance Division, 335 Merchant Street, Room 213, Honolulu, Hawaii 96813. The \$1.25 charge will be due and payable at the time of picking up the proposed filing.

Further, the proposed filing may be reviewed in person free of charge at the Insurance Division at the address and hours of operation noted above.
