#### **VARSITY PROGRAM OVERVIEW**

LifeSmarts helps students learn about their consumer rights and responsibilities and develop marketplace smarts. Varsity teams must be in grades 9-12 and must submit a release form to participate at in-person competitions.

Teams are formed under the guidance of an adult coach/teacher that must register with the NCL through <a href="www.lifesmarts.org">www.lifesmarts.org</a>. A team consists of one coach and at least four team members. Teams first compete in the online competition, independently completing three levels of questions in the following categories:



Schools and organizations may enter more than one coach and coaches may have multiple teams in the competition. Qualifying teams in the varsity program will advance to the state in-person competition. The winning team will be eligible to represent Hawaii at the national competition.

Coaches have access to useful tools: TeamSmarts monthly team activity, LifeSmarts U's virtual classroom, pre-test and post-test scores to assess students' learning, on-line lessons, practice rounds of competition, scavenger hunts, fast facts, a question of the day calendar and much more.
