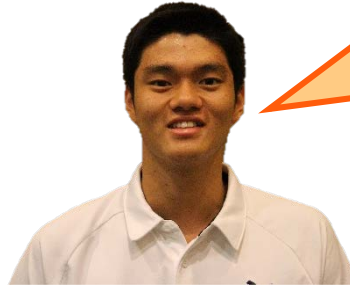
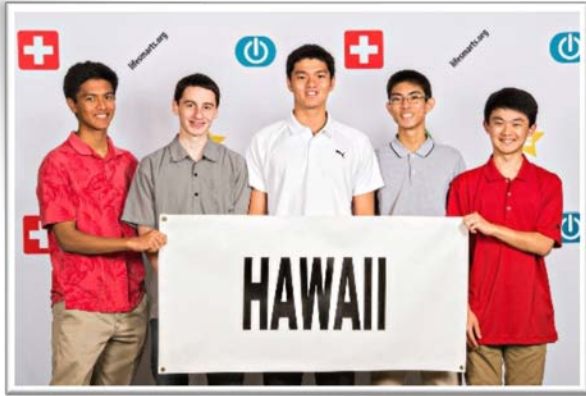

2016 Hawaii LifeSmarts team members from Iolani School share about their educational experience at the National Competition that was held in Denver, CO on April 9-12, 2016.

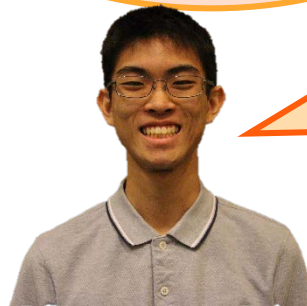
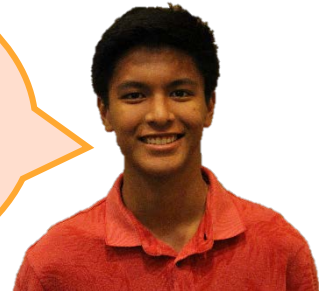


"This experience was fun; something I will never forget. I don't think I've ever been on an academic competition team before. It was an honor to not only represent Iolani but the state as well."

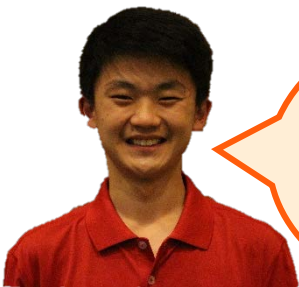


"This was a great opportunity which allowed me to experience new things and learn a lot about life. This was by far the best organized competition that I've ever been to. I learned to do my best and never give up."
