After due consideration of the information received, as well as oral testimony provided by Dr. Johnson, Cathy Meyer-Uyehara, Clayton Uyehara, and Jay Dee Penn, it was moved by Dr. Geimer-Flanders, seconded by Dr. Bintliff and unanimously carried to deny Dr. Johnson's application for medical licensure, basing its decision on the following grounds of the Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS"), which find factual support in the records and files of Dr. Johnson's application:

- HRS § 453-8(a)(7): Professional misconduct, hazardous negligence causing bodily injury to another, or manifest incapacity in the practice of medicine, osteopathy, or surgery;
- HRS § 453-8(a)(8): Incompetence or multiple instances of negligence, including but not limited to the consistent use of medical service, which is inappropriate or unnecessary;
- HRS § 453-8(a)(9): Conduct or practice contrary to the recognized standards of ethics for the medical profession as adopted by the Hawaii Medical Association, the American Medical Association, the Hawaii Osteopathic Physicians and Surgeons, or the American Osteopathic Association;

- HRS § 453-8(a)(11): Revocation, suspension, or other disciplinary action by another state or federal agency of a license, certificate, or medical privilege for reasons as provided in this section;
- HRS § 453-8(a)(12): Conviction, whether by nolo contendere or otherwise, of a penal offense substantially related to the qualifications, functions, or duties of a physician or osteopathic physician, notwithstanding any statutory provision the to the contrary;
- HRS § 453-8(a)(15): Submitting to or filing with the board any notice, statement, or other document required under this chapter, which is false or untrue or contains any material misstatement or omission of fact;
- HRS § 436B-19(8): Failure to maintain a record or history of competency, trustworthiness, fair dealing, and financial integrity; and
- HRS § 436B-19(12): Failure to comply, observe, or adhere to any law in a manner such that the licensing authority deems the applicant or holder to be an unfit or improper person to hold a license.

Executive Officer Quiogue advised Mr. Tenorio that Constance Cabral, former Executive Officer of Hawaii Medical Board, attended a meeting today with Blake Oshiro, the Governor's Deputy Chief of Staff, Senator Josh Green, Fielding Mercer and others. Because time was of the essence, it was proposed by Mr. Mercer to narrow the scope even further by limiting the rules revision to Schedule II and address the other revisions at a later date.

As such, the Schedule II rule revision is being sent to the Attorney General's Office, Legislative Reference Bureau and the Regulated Industries Complaints Office for review and recommendation. After their review, other agencies will also have the opportunity to review and comment. Because of this, the Board is unable to anticipate when the rules would be adopted. However, the Board is
