<u>Adjudicatory</u> <u>Matters</u> :	Chair Desai called for a recess from the meeting at 12:30 p.m. to discuss and deliberate on the following adjudicatory matters pursuant to HRS Chapter 91.

a. <u>In the Matter of the License to Practice Medicine of John F. Balog,</u> <u>M.D.; MED 2013-76-L; MED 2013-78-L; MED 2013-79-L</u>

After discussion, it was moved by Dr. Holt, seconded by Dr. Kosasa and unanimously carried to accept the Settlement Agreement Prior to Filing of Petition for Disciplinary Action and Board's Final Order.

b. <u>In the Matter of the License to Practice Medicine of Igor Mitreski,</u> <u>M.D.; MED 2014-35-L</u>

After discussion, it was moved by Dr. Halford, seconded by Dr. Sept and unanimously carried to accept the Settlement Agreement Prior to Filing of Petition for Disciplinary Action and Board's Final Order.

Following the Board's review, deliberation and decision in this matter pursuant to Chapter 91, HRS, Chair Desai announced that the Board reconvene to its regular Chapter 92, HRS, meeting at 12:33 p.m.

<u>New Business:</u> a. <u>Consideration of Amendment to Chapter 16-85, Hawaii</u> <u>Administrative Rules</u>

Chair Desai called for a discussion on the proposed rule amendment. He stated that the purpose of the proposed amendment is to delete the provision that requires applicants for a medical license to pass all three steps of the United States Medical Licensing Examination (USMLE) within seven years.

Dr. Halford asked why the Board was considering eliminating the seven year policy.

Executive Officer Quiogue explained that physicians who pursued dual degrees are typical of those who are unable to meet the 7-year rule. This is because steps 1 and 2 of the USMLE are taken in medical school and step 3 is taken after the 1st year of residency. Dual-degreed applicants complete medical school, enter a doctoral degree research program, and after completion of the doctorate degree, enter a residency program. As such, it is almost impossible for them to meet the 7-year requirement.

After discussion, it was moved by Dr. Kosasa, seconded by Dr. Holt, and unanimously carried to adopt the rule amendment presented at the public hearing.

<u>Correspondence:</u> a. <u>Request for Informal Opinion Regarding Certification of Medical</u> <u>Marijuana Patients</u> Hawaii Medical Board Minutes of Meeting of December 11, 2014 Page 5

The Board received a letter from Clifton Otto, M.D., requesting an informal opinion from the Board regarding the certification of medical marijuana patients by physicians in Hawaii. Specifically, Dr. Otto requests that the Board consider adopting an informal opinion which would provide guidelines that physicians can follow in order to ensure that their certification examinations meet the standard of medical care in Hawaii, and that their medical licenses will not be threatened by performing such a medical intervention.

Dr. David Barton appeared before the Board to discuss this matter. Dr. Barton stated that this is a very important issue which requires the legislature's involvement on all islands. He informed the Board that this matter has been discussed with Senators Baker and Green.

Dr. Barton further stated that their goal is to set the highest standards for physicians to adhere to so that they may provide appropriate and necessary care.

Dr. Barton informed the Board that he has personally encountered, and is aware of physicians who are currently certifying patients for medical marijuana without first establishing an appropriate doctor-patient relationship.

Dr. Barton indicated that he is aware of physician who lost his medical license in the state of California for inappropriate prescribing of medical marijuana, but is still currently licensed by the Board. Dr. Barton again emphasized the importance of raising the bar to avoid these problems.

DAG Wong informed Dr. Barton that if he is aware of physicians engaged in misconduct, he may at any time contact the Regulated Industries Complaints Office to file a complaint. She went on to say that he should refrain from providing specific information to the Board regarding the alleged misconduct of a licensee that may be the subject of a disciplinary case before the Board at a later date.

Chair Desai informed Dr. Barton that the subject of certification of medical marijuana patients now falls within the purview of the Department of Health ("DOH"), after being transferred from the Department of Public Safety. It is his understanding that DOH will be establishing rules that may address Dr. Barton's concerns and, thus, suggested deferring Board discussion of the matter at this time.

Being that there were no further questions, Chair Desai thanked Dr. Barton for attending the Board's meeting, and excused him from the meeting room.

Discussion followed. It was moved by Chair Desai, seconded by Dr. Kosasa, and unanimously carried to defer this matter.

b. <u>The Validity of Prescriptions</u>

Members reviewed an email from Ms. Alanna Isobe dated November 17, 2014, regarding the validity of prescriptions after a physician passes away. Specifically, Ms. Isobe inquired whether refills or new prescriptions issued before a physician passes away remain valid after the physician passes away.

After discussion, it was determined that prescriptions are valid until it expires or there are no longer refills. Furthermore, members instructed Executive Officer Quiogue to inform Ms. Isobe that pharmacists should use their professional judgment regarding whether a prescription should be filled or not. If a pharmacist, in their professional capacity, believes that a prescription should not be filled, then they have the discretion to refuse to fill that prescription.

c. <u>Necessity of Medical License for Training Activity: Physicians</u> <u>Providing Training Sessions for FDA-approved Non-surgical</u> <u>Devise to Treat Hemmorrhoids</u>

This matter was deferred for further review and discussion.

d. The Optometric Society: Opternative

The Board was provided a letter from The Optometric Society dated November 25, 2014, regarding opternative for informational purposes only.

For the Board's information, opternative is an online refractive eye exam after which glasses or contact lens prescription is given, and is signed by an ophthalmologist.
