Call to Order: There being a quorum present, the meeting was called to order at 9:51 a.m. by Chairperson Inouye.

Additions Or Revisions To the Agenda: None.

Approval of the Board Minutes: It was moved by Vice Chairperson Galas, seconded by Mr. Chang and unanimously carried to approve the Board minutes and executive session minutes of the February 12, 2015 meeting.

It was moved by Vice Chairperson Galas, seconded by Chief Kubojiri and unanimously carried to **ratify** the approval of the Guard Employees assigned registration numbers GDE-12497–13003 (see the attached list).

Chairperson Inouye announced he was taking the agenda out of order to address Act 208 (SLH 2010) and Any Matters Relating to its Implementation.

Act 208 (SLH 2010)
and Any Matters
Relating to its
Implementation:

a. Initial 8 Hour Security Guard Training Curricula

(i) Classroom Definition

The Board reviewed the email reply from Preshess Willets-Vaquilar, Program Coordinator at Windward community College Career & Community Education informing the Board that there is no one policy on what is deemed a “classroom” now with the inclusion of online training opportunities, a classroom can either be virtual or physically in-person. The

inclusion of quizzes and exams to ensure participant understanding is left up to the instructor. There should be a registration component to include proof of identification to ensure the identity of the person actually taking the class.

The Executive Officer indicated that she is in contact with Keala Chock, Dean at Honolulu Community college to discuss this matter.

Vice Chairperson Galas volunteered to further research definitions of classroom for both the 8 Hour Initial and Continuing Education training. This matter was deferred pending Vice Chairperson Galas' report.

b. HRS 463-10.5 (c) and (g) Regarding Continuing Education

The Executive Officer provided HRS chapter 463-10.5 (c) and (g) which are the statutory sections that refer to classroom instruction for the initial 8 hours of training and the 4 hours of continuing education required for renewal. HRS chapter 463-10.5 (c) and (g) is as follows:

(c) Guards and individuals acting in a guard capacity shall successfully complete the classroom instruction specified by this section, pass a written test, and undergo four hours of on-the-job training supervised by an individual who has successfully completed all of the 6 requirements of this section or who has otherwise been approved by the board for on-the-job training. Guards and individuals acting in a guard capacity shall successfully complete:

- (1) Eight hours of classroom instruction before the first day of service; and
- (2) Four hours of classroom instruction biennially thereafter; provided that in addition to relevant guard industry material, the required classroom instruction shall include a refresher component on professional image and aloha training.

(g) Prior to the June 30, 2016 renewal of the guard registration and every registration renewal thereafter, the applicant shall pay all required fees, and have had at least four hours of continuing education as specified in the rules of the board.

It is this statutory reference to "classroom instruction" that the Board is researching this matter to determine whether a "Skype" or distance learning format of training meets the statutory mandate.

Chairperson Inouye announced he was taking the agenda out of order to address c. (iii) Instructions for “Yes” answers and acknowledged guest, Jeff Owens.

c. Application Form Inclusions & Deletions – Guard or Private Detective, Detective or Guard Agency and Guar Employee Registration

(iii) Instructions for “Yes” answers.

Mr. Owens informed the Board that the guard employee registration application requires the applicant to submit burdensome information for a “YES” answer and asks the Board to consider rewording the application or to just ask for attestations only.

DAG Tam informed Mr. Owens that every Board cannot deny an application because of the applicant’s criminal convictions unless the conviction is directly related to the profession and the conviction cannot be held against the applicant if the applicant is sufficiently rehabilitated. Previously employers have said that they have lost applicants because they were waiting for their deficiency notices. So in order to expedite the application process, the application was worded to ask for the conviction information up front.

The Executive Officer informed Mr. Owens that the Board’s burden is to look at all criminal convictions and by asking for the information up front expedites the process. Chairperson Inouye added further that if the Board does not look at all convictions, the Board may not be able to justify its decision to deny or approve if an employer or the public question why an applicant was or was not issued a card.

Mr. Owens stated that employers may lose potential employees if applicants are required to produce court documents and letters of recommendation. The Executive Officer responded that there are some employers who depend on the Board’s review because they are unable to obtain or request national criminal history from their applicants. Chairperson Inouye added that it was not the Board’s responsibility to protect the employee from their employer if a request for a letter of recommendation reveals that the employee is seeking other employment or that the employee has a criminal conviction.

Mr. Owens submitted the following draft response to question #6 on the application:

If "YES", submit a written statement signed by you attesting that you have met all terms and conditions imposed by the Court regarding each conviction and that the case has been discharged. If you are still under the supervision of a judicial or parole authority, submit a statement on official letterhead from that authority stating that it is their position that the reason you are under their supervision is not a reason to deny you a license to work in a guard capacity.

You are advised that submitting a letter or statement containing false information is a criminal misdemeanor offense under Hawaii Revised Statute §710-1063 Unsworn falsification to authorities.

It was the Board's concerns that as the Board is charged with the review an applicant's criminal history and determination as to whether an applicant is fit to be issued a guard registration, the Board cannot rely solely upon an applicant's attestation, and that court documentation, letters from an employer, members of the community attesting to the applicants rehabilitation, reliability and trustworthiness are required to determine an applicant's fitness.

The Executive Officer informed the Board that in the "Instructions for 'YES' Answers to Questions (4) through (6) of the Application for License (PDG-02)", A. 2) iv. will be deleted and replaced and instruction v. will be added as follows:

- iv. Letters of recommendation from any physicians, counselors, and other members of the community (no relative) who can objectively attest in writing to a firm belief that you have been sufficiently rehabilitated to warrant the public's trust.
- v. Letters of recommendation from your current employer regarding your reliability and trustworthiness to work as a principal detective or principal guard.

Chairperson Inouye thanked Mr. Owens for his comments.

Chairperson Inouye announced that he was returning to the order of the agenda.

c. Application Form Inclusions & Deletions – Guard or Private Detective, Detective or Guard Agency and Guard Employee Registration

(i) Applicant Notification and Record Challenge (FBI)

The Executive Officer notified the Board that as a result of the recent FBI audit, the following statement is required by the FBI and will be included in the FBI section of the Guard or Private Detective, Detective or Guard Agency and Guard Employee Registration application forms:

Applicant Notification and Record Challenge:
Your fingerprints will be used to check the criminal history records of the FBI. You have the opportunity to complete or challenge the accuracy of the information contained in the FBI identification record. The procedure for obtaining a change, correction, or updating an FBI identification record are set forth in Title 28, CFR, 16.34.

(ii) Psychiatric or Psychological History

The Executive Officer informed the Board that the following amendments to the Psychiatric or Psychological History

instructions for the Sole Proprietor or Principal application will be amended to read as follows:

If you are presently suffering from a psychiatric or psychological disorder, please submit the following:

- An explanation of the underlying facts and circumstances surrounding your psychiatric/psychological disorder and treatment.
- Letters from your treating licensed health care practitioner (e.g. psychologist, psychiatrist, psychiatric mental health nurse practitioner, adult psychiatric and mental health clinical nurse specialist) regarding the diagnosis, status of your psychiatric or psychological disorder and assessment of your ability to work in the registered/licensed profession (principal guard or principal detective).
- Letters of recommendation from your current employer regarding your reliability, trustworthiness and ability to work as a principal guard or principal detective.

The amendments also reflect additions to the health care practitioners who are able to diagnose, treat, and assess a psychiatric or psychological disorder.

d. Scope

- (i) Correspondence Requesting Clarification of Act 208 (SLH 2010) Requirement for Traffic Control Personnel.

The Board reviewed the correspondence from Mark Lafita of Aloha Security, Inc. regarding whether all personnel providing traffic control services should be registered as guards, and whether the company providing such services should have an agency license.

Based solely on the information provided in the letter, the Board was unable to answer the inquiry because the letter did not provide the specific duties and responsibilities of the “traffic control services” employees. Accordingly, if the individual performing “traffic control services” falls within the following definition of a “guard under HRS section 463-1, registration under HRS section 463-10.5 is required:

“Guard’ means a registered uniformed or nonuniformed person responsible for the

safekeeping of a client's properties and persons within contractually prescribed boundaries, and for observation and reporting relative to such safekeeping. 'Guard' shall not include any active duty federal, state, or county law enforcement officers or personnel."

The board also determined that if registration is required, the company providing the "guard" service, shall be required to obtain a guard agency license pursuant to HRS section 463-7 which states in relevant part:

§463-7(b) No firm shall engage in the business of guard for the purpose of protecting persons or property or to prevent theft or unlawful taking of goods, wares, merchandise, money, bonds, documents, or other articles of value for hire or reward or represent itself to be, hold itself out as, list itself as, or advertise as a guard agency without first obtaining a license as a guard agency from the board and paying the application and license fees. A guard agency shall have in its employ at least one principal guard who shall be fully responsible for the direct management and control of the guard agency and the agency's employees when guard services are being provided.

- (ii) Email Inquiring If Act 208 (SLH 2010) Applies to Traffic Control Agents.

The Board reviewed the email from Mr. Heaukulani regarding whether traffic control agents are subject to the registration requirement of Act 208 and HRS chapter 463.

Based upon the information provided in the email the Board determined that traffic control agents unless duties are specifically defined, does not in itself subject these employees to Act 208 and HRS Chapter 463. The Board also determined that it had insufficient information to make any determination as to whether the duties of traffic control agents fall within the definition of a "guard" in HRS Chapter 463-1 as follows:

"Guard" means a registered uniformed or nonuniformed person responsible for the safekeeping of a client's properties and persons within contractually prescribed boundaries, and for observation and reporting relative to such safekeeping. "Guard" shall not include any active

duty federal, state, or county law enforcement
officers or personnel.
