Executive Officer's
Report:

a. Pepper Spray

The Executive Officer asked the Board if pepper spray is considered to be a chemical spray and therefore prohibited? The Board reviewed section 16-97-17 which prohibits the carrying of any weapon unless authorized in writing by the appropriate state agency or chief of police. Mr. Chang responded that training is required in the use of pepper spray and Chief Kubojiri added that training is required for care after the use of pepper spray in case of respiratory problems. Thus it was moved by Mr. Chang, seconded by Chief Kubojiri and unanimously carried that any type of spray even naturally derived irritant sprays should still be approved by the appropriate county police chief for use in that county.

The Executive Officer reported that the Exam committee recommends 1 reference for each exam (principal guard and private detective) and that the Board is responsible for the development of the exams.

Ms. Kubota and Mr. Chang are still in the process of selecting the references. Once selected, Ms. Kubota will aid the committee exam question development.
