4. <u>Rules Committee</u>: Tyrus Kagawa, Chairperson

<u>Proposed Amendments to HAR Chapter 16-77 and Recommendations from</u> the Investigative Committee

Chairperson Kagawa of the Rules Committee reported that at the last Board meeting, the Rules Investigative Committee recommended three separate rule amendment packages: (1) specialty contractor classifications; (2) "incidental and supplemental"; and (3) "A" General Engineering, "B" General Building, and C-5 Cabinet, millwork, and carpentry remodeling and repairs classifications. The Board will move forward with the proposed amendments to HAR chapter 77, which includes rule package amendments for (1) and (2) above, and these amendments were made available at the meeting. The Board will be discussing (3) above at a later meeting.

Chairperson Kagawa asked the audience for any comments or discussion on rule package (1). Mr. Matsusugu asked for clarification that the Board will be just adopting the Investigative Committee's recommendations today. Mr. Kagawa related "yes", the Board will be discussing the Investigative Committee's recommendations and taking action on the committee's recommendations.

Chairperson Kagawa asked for any comments or discussion on rule package (2) regarding "incidental and supplemental".

Dwayne Arelliano of the Glaziers stated that their issue is the Board's interpretation that "majority" means any amount greater than 50% and they have testified on this many times before. This means that anything 49% and less is considered "incidental and supplemental".

Ron Amemiya of the Ironworkers asked when the rules process will begin and if the rules will be adopted next year. DAG Tam stated that after the Board agrees to the proposed amendments, the rule process will begin. The rule amendment process is lengthy and we cannot give a date that the proposed rules may be approved by the Governor. The proposed rule amendments must be reviewed by many agencies including but not limited to, the Attorney General, Legislative Reference Bureau, Budget and Finance, and the Small Business Regulatory Review Board. After responses from the agencies, then the Board has to request a public hearing from the Governor. The notice of public hearing then has to be published in the newspapers to allow the public to attend and comment on any proposed changes.

Executive Officer Tamanaha asked that anyone wishing to comment on the proposed amendments submit their comments and recommendations now, before we reach the public hearing so that the Board may consider their comments and recommendations prior to starting the rule amendment process. Thus, if anyone has concerns on the Board's proposed

amendments, the Board would appreciate receiving written recommendations on amendments for its consideration.

Kika Bukoski, Executive Director of the Hawaii Building & Construction Trades Council, thanked the Board for the work they do as he understands it is not easy because of the many differences of opinion on this subject.

Mr. Bukoski stated that, as an example, if a structural steel subcontractor bids on a contract and the primary work is structural steel, but there is work of lesser importance but greater than a majority, will this work still be considered "incidental and supplemental"? If the scope of the trade is considered primary work and there is other work subordinate to the primary work, under the definition of majority, it wouldn't be incidental and supplemental if it is greater than 50%. He stated that he did not have a chance to thoroughly read and think through what it means, but he felt the proposed language in section 16-77-34 may conflict with HRS section 444-8. This section of the statute states that "incidental and supplemental" only applies to specialty contractor licenses. The statute does not say that the "incidental and supplemental" must be subordinate and directly related to the primary work. Executive Officer Tamanaha asked Mr. Bukoski to submit his comments and recommendations in writing to the Board. Mr. Bukoski will review and think about the Board's proposed amendments.

Jeffrey Masatsugu, representing District Council 50, stated that he did not have a chance to thoroughly review the Board's proposed rule amendments, and would like to reserve the option to submit comments later. However, at first glance, his concern was that "majority" means any amount greater than 50%. Fifty percent appears to be too high and would allow the general contractor to perform the work in a majority of cases. He was aware that recommendations were made to the Legislature but did not know if what was presented today is the same as those submitted to the Legislature.

Executive Officer Ito stated that the proposed amendments distributed today are those amendments in addition to the Board's 2014 report to the Legislature in response to SCR No. 84, SD1 (SLH 2013) but excluding the "A", "B", and C-5 classifications package. This last package will be taken up separately at a later time with no specific time frame in mind.

Gregg Serikaku, Executive Director of the Plumbing and Mechanical Contractors Association of Hawaii ("PAMCA"), suggested that a change in subsection (a) of the proposed rule amendments on HAR section 16-77-34 be made by inserting the words "craft or trade work" instead of "work" to be consistent with the statutes. He also stated that if he understands it correctly, "majority" came up because of the court's ruling that work must not make up a majority of the project. It also said that "incidental" is defined as having a minor role. "Incidental and supplemental" only allows limited amounts of work outside the contractors scope and must be interpreted narrowly. PAMCA believes that the Board's proposed definition of "majority" does not satisfy the intent of "incidental and supplemental" because 50% is not narrow.

Mr. Serikaku proposed that the Board take out the phrase "less than a majority" in (b) and also omit (c) from the proposed amendments or clearly state the intent of "incidental and supplemental". Mr. Serikaku will submit his proposed amendments in writing to the Board.

Mr. Bukoski asked that the Board consider testimony and responses that were submitted in August 2013 by the Hawaii Building & Construction Trades Council, which addressed several items included in the SCR 84 report. They also had submitted recommended language for HAR section 16-77-34. Their concern is that "incidental and supplemental" work should only be applied to specialty contractors as defined in HRS section 444-7(d).

Chairperson Kagawa asked for further comments from the audience and there were none.

It was then moved by Mr. Mochida, seconded by Mr. Lee, and carried (with Mr. Matsuzaki abstaining) to approve Investigative Committee's rule amendments presented at the October 24, 2014 meeting.

Steven Booth Songstad, Wayne's Carpet Maui – Mr. Songstad asked, with regard to the installation of floors, is a C-55 Waterproofing contractor license necessary to install moisture vapor mitigation treatment?

Mr. Konishi asked if there were any comments from the audience.

Pele Lui-Yuen of the Local 1926 Flooring Union stated that the C-55 is not required to install the moisture vapor mitigation treatment, as the general or roofing contractors perform this type of work. C-55 Waterproofing and moisture vapor mitigation are two separate things. The flooring contractors must check the water moisture in the floors before installing the flooring. Too much vapor can cause the flooring to puff up. They have to be certified by the manufacturer to do this work.

Mr. Masatsugu of DC 50 stated that a lot of flooring products have specifications and instructions on how to install vapor barriers as part of the flooring process or the warranty will be voided. In order to have it installed correctly, the floorer should be the one to install vapor barriers.

When asked by Mr. Lee which licenses can install the vapor moisture barriers, Mr. Lui-Yuen stated that only the C-7 Carpet laying, C-21 Flooring and C-51 Tile classifications can install the vapor moisture barriers. They

have to always test the floor for moisture levels and the warranty will be voided if not done correctly.

<u>Recommendation</u>: No; provided that the moisture vapor mitigation treatment is part of the flooring system.

It was moved by Mr. Lee, seconded by Mr. Suehiro, and unanimously carried to approve the above scope recommendation.
