Call to Order: There being a quorum present, Chairperson Akasaki called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

Agenda: The agenda for this meeting was filed with the Office of the Lieutenant Governor, as required by Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") section 92-7(b).

The Board noted that the mechanical process piping and pipefitting work mentioned in the Board's response to Question #1 of Nan Inc.'s inquiry is limited solely to the piping carrying sewage for the sewage lift station depicted in Drawing Sheets M-001 to M-903 of the Kailua Regional Waste Water Treatment Plant Tunnel Influent Pump Station and Headworks Facility project. Chapter 91, HRS, Adjudicatory Matters:

Chairperson Akasaki called for a recess from the Board's meeting at 8:50 a.m. to discuss and deliberate on the following adjudicatory matters pursuant to HRS chapter 91.

- 1. Settlement Agreements
 - a. In the Matter of the Contractors Licenses of David A. Nice, RME; CLB 2014-362-L

David A. Nice ("Respondent Nice") and David A. Nice Builders, Inc. ("Respondent Nice Builders") were issued licenses on September 11, 2000. Respondents are licensed in the "B" General Building classification. Respondent Nice has been the principal RME for Respondent Nice Builders since September 11,

2000.

RICO received a complaint alleging that Respondent Nice was not in residence in the State of Hawaii while Respondent Nice Builders was constructing the Tourneau retail store in the Royal Hawaiian Shopping Center.

If proven at an administrative hearing, the allegations would constitute violations of the following rules:

- HAR section 16-77-71(a)(4) (RME shall be in residence in Hawaii during the period a project is under constructions); and
- HAR section 16-77-71(a)(5) (RME shall be held responsible for any violation of HAR).

Respondents state that they were not aware of the RME residency requirement and that they have since had several employees apply as subordinate RMEs to ensure compliance in the future.

Respondents do not admit to violating any law or rule, and agree to pay, jointly and severally, an administrative fine of \$7,500.00

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Lee, seconded by Mr. Leong, and unanimously carried to approve the Settlement Agreement Prior to Filing of Petition for Disciplinary Action and Board's Final Order in the above case.

b. In the Matter of the Contractors License of Freddie B. Berengue; CLB 2014-382-L

Freddie B. Berengue ("Respondent") was licensed on or about December 2, 1985. The Board noted that Respondent is licensed in the C-7 Carpet laying specialty classification, and not the "B" General building contractor classification.

RICO alleges that the Respondent failed to disclose that he was convicted of two separate petty misdemeanor offenses of Operating a Vehicle Under the Influence of an Intoxicant on October 29, 2012 and May 21, 2014 in the District Court of the Third Circuit, State of Hawaii, on his 2014 renewal application that he dated August 24, 2014 and subsequently submitted to the Professional and Vocational Licensing Division of the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs.

If proven at an administrative hearing, the allegations would constitute violations of the following statutes(s) and/or rule(s):

- HRS section 436B-19(5) (procuring a license through

- fraud, misrepresentation, or deceit); and
- HRS section 444-17(10) (misrepresenting a material fact by applicant in obtaining a license).

Respondent mistakenly believed that he was only required to report felony convictions on his 2014 renewal application.

Respondent does not admit to violating any law or rule, and agrees to pay an administrative fine of \$500.00.

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Mochida, seconded by Mr. Konishi, and unanimously carried to approve the Settlement Agreement Prior to Filing of Petition for Disciplinary Action and Board's Final Order in the above case.

County of Maui, Department of Parks and Recreation – Requests a determination on whether a "B" General Building contractor is permitted to perform the reconstruction of a fire damaged restroom building. The contractor listed the following specialty contractors as subcontractors, but self-performed the installation of the asphalt shingle roofing and ceramic tile: C-13 Electrical contractor, C-37 Plumbing contractor, C-42 Roofing contractor, C-51 Tile contractor, and C-33 Painting and decorating contractor.

Recommendation: The C-42 Roofing contractor's license is required to perform the installation of asphalt shingle roofing, and the C-51 Tile contractor's license is required to perform the installation of ceramic tile, on the project.

A person licensed in only the "B" General Building contractor classification is not allowed to perform the installation of asphalt shingle roofing and ceramic tile for the Pukalani Park fire-damaged restroom building project without the C-42 and C-51 contractor's licenses.

Goldbrecht Inc. – Requests an exemption from HRS chapter 444 to install the Swiss Made Vitrocsa window and door systems.

Recommendation: The exemption in HRS sections 444-2(9) does not apply to the installation of Victrosca window and door systems, and that a C-22 Glazing and tinting contractor's license is required to install Victrosca window and door systems.

Nan Inc. – Requests a determination whether an “A” General engineering contractor or other specialty contractor's license is required to install light rail track on the Honolulu Rail project.

Recommendation: The “A” General engineering contractor, through its C-31a Cement concrete and C-56 Welding contractor's licenses, may install light rail track on the Honolulu Rail Project.

Senior Citizen Consumer – Requests a determination on whether a contractor's license is required to modify existing bathtubs to create a low walk thru entrance into the bathtub.

Recommendation: Based solely on the information provided, no license is required to modify existing bathtubs to create a low walk thru entrance into the bathtub.
