Chapter 91, HRS, Adjudicatory Matters:

Chairperson Akasaki called for a recess from the Board's meeting at 8:32 a.m. to discuss and deliberate on the following adjudicatory matters pursuant to HRS chapter 91.

1. <u>Settlement Agreements</u>

a. <u>In the Matter of the Contractors Licenses of Horizon Retail</u>
<u>Construction, Inc., and Jon E. Hendersen;</u> CLB 2015-216-L

Respondent Horizon Retail Construction, Inc. ("Respondent Horizon") and Jon E. Hendersen ("Respondent <u>Hendersen</u>") are licensed as general contractors. The licenses were issued on or about October 11, 1994; and are due expire or forfeit on or about September 30, 2016. At all relevant times herein, Respondent <u>Hendersen</u> was the Responsible Managing Employee for Respondent Horizon.

RICO alleges that Respondent <u>Hendersen</u> was not in residence in Hawaii while Respondents' Coach Inc. store construction project was under construction at Ala Moana Center.

RICO further alleges that Respondents aided or abetted Visionary General Contracting, LLC by subcontracting work to the unlicensed entity.

If proven at an administrative hearing, the allegations would constitute violations of the following laws and rule:

- HRS section 444-9.3 (aiding or abetting unlicensed person);
- HRS section 444-17(12) (failure to comply with statute or rules);
 and
- HAR section 16-77-71(a)(4) (responsible managing employee not in residence).

Respondents do not admit to violating any law or rule and agree to pay an administrative fine, jointly and severally, in the amount of \$50,000.00

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Lee, seconded by Mr. Polishcheck, and unanimously carried to approve the Settlement Agreement Prior to Filing of Petition for Disciplinary Action and Board's Final Order in the above case.

b. <u>In the Matter of the Contractor's License of Kurt B. Kaminski, dba</u> <u>Puna Construction;</u> CLB 2016-26-L

Respondent Kurt B. Kaminski, dba Puna Construction ("Respondent") was issued license number CT-18315 on or about May 28, 1993; and will expire or forfeit on or about September 30, 2016.

On or about March 20, 2013, a Judgment of Conviction was entered against Respondent finding Respondent guilty of one count of operating a vehicle under the influence of an intoxicant in violation of HRS section 291E-(61)(a) and one count of driving while license suspended or revoked in violation of HRS section 286-132.

Respondent paid a fine, underwent substance abuse counseling and completed all of the terms of his sentence as of September 26, 2013.

On his renewal application dated August 28, 2014, in response to question number 3, which asks, "In the past 2 years have you been convicted of a crime in which the conviction has not been annulled or expunged?" Respondent answered "no."

Respondent admits to the veracity of the factual statements and admits that Respondent's acts violate HRS section 436B-19(2) (making an untruthful or improbable statement), and agrees to pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$500.00.

Respondent understands that RICO enters into this settlement agreement, and agrees to the specific terms contained in this settlement agreement based upon Respondent's representations that the conviction did not relate to his business and that Respondent has no convictions for driving while intoxicated and/or driving under the influence of alcohol or intoxicating substances since the March 20, 2013 conviction.

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Konishi, seconded by Mr. Lee, and unanimously carried to approve the Settlement Agreement Prior to Filing of Petition for Disciplinary Action and Board's Final Order in the above case.

c. <u>In the Matter of the Contractors' Licenses of Retail Construction</u> Services, Inc., and Stephen M. Bachman; CLB 2015-333-L

Respondent Retail Construction Services, Inc. ("Respondent Retail") and Respondent Stephen M. Bachman ("Respondent Bachman") are licensed as general building contractors. The licenses were issued on or about March 15, 1993; and are due to expire or forfeit on or about September 30, 2016. At all relevant times herein, Respondent Bachman was the Responsible Managing Employee for Respondent Retail.

RICO alleges that Respondent Bachman was not in residence in Hawaii for periods of time while Respondents' project was under construction in Hawaii.

RICO also alleges that Respondent Retail hired an unlicensed welder, Aloha Welding Inc., to perform welding work on a construction project in the State of Hawaii. If proven at an administrative hearing, the allegations would constitute violations of the following laws and rule:

- HRS section 436B-19(17) (violating chapter or applicable licensing laws);
- HRS section 444-17(17) (entering into a contract with an unlicensed contractor); and
- HAR section 16-77-71(a)(4) (RME shall be in residence in the State during the period a project is under construction).

Respondents do not admit to violating any law or rule, and agree to pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$12,500.00.

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Lee, seconded by Mr. Matsuoka, and unanimously carried to approve the Settlement Agreement Prior to Filing of Petition for Disciplinary Action and Board's Final Order in the above case.

The Contractors Examination Summary for March 2016 was distributed to the Board for their information.

2. Recovery/Education Fund Committee:

The Recovery Fund Litigation Report for March 19, 2016 to April 15, 2016 prepared by Ronald Michioka, Esq., the Board's Recovery Fund Attorney, was distributed to the Board for their information.

3. <u>Legislation Committee</u>: Peter H. M. Lee, Chairperson

Mr. Lee presented the Legislation Committee Report. A summary was distributed to the Board for their review and comment.

S.B. No. 3092, S.D. 2, H.D. 1 – On March 21, 2016 the House Committee on Consumer Protection & Commerce ("CPC") held a hearing on S.B. No. 3092, S.D. 2, H.D. 1 and decision making on March 23, 2016. The Board submitted comments on this measure that it is concerned that the proposed language conflicts with the contractor's law and the Board's longstanding interpretation that a person must be licensed as a contractor at the time of submitting a proposal or bid on a construction project. The Board also asked for clarification that the proposed amendments will not override or negate the Board's disciplinary powers under HRS chapter 444.

The Committee passed S.B. No. 3092, S.D. 2, H.D. 1 with amendments proposed by the General Contractors Association ("GCA"). The proposed amendments specified that the procurement officer may only consider a listed subcontractor's license as valid if the subcontractor was previously licensed within sixty days prior to bid opening.

S.B. No. 3092, S.D. 2, H.D.2 – On March 30, 2016 the House Committee on Finance ("FIN") held a hearing on S.B. No. 3092, S.D. 2, H.D. 2. The Board submitted similar testimony that was presented to the CPC.

The FIN recommended that the measure be deferred.

Mr. Lee reported that the State Procurement Office ("SPO") met with GCA, RICO, DAGS Public Works, and the CLB (Mr. Lee represented the Board) to come to a consensus on proposed amendments. The parties were not able to agree on proposed amendments. Without agreement between the parties, FIN will not schedule decision making on this bill and it will remain deferred.

Glenn Del Rosario – Requests clarification whether "metal and metal shingles" includes corrugated metal roofing; and whether the "B" General building classification covers building renovations, new structures, all interior and exterior work including the roofing.

Arnold Wong of the Ironworkers Local Union 625 Stabilization Fund asked if it was a residential project. Executive Officer Ito answered that the inquiry is regarding commercial and residential projects. Mr. Wong stated that if it's a commercial project involving steel purlins and structural steel, a C-48 Structural steel contractor's license should be required.

Jeff Masatsugu, Floorlayers MRF, asked what the particular project is. Executive Officer Ito answered that it appears to be a general question.

Recommendation: Defer this matter for additional information on the work that is being performed: specifically, the Board requests a description of the scope of work and details on the corrugated roof that will be installed, including but not limited to, plans and specifications for the project, type of corrugated roofing or other roofing being installed, and the cost and extent of the roofing work in relation to the total cost or extent of the entire project.
