HRS:The Committee reviewed and approved the minutes of the March 4,
2015 meeting. In discussing possible provisions for future rules
amendments, the Committee deleted "Architect specialization" and
"Addition of photogrammetry questions to the State Board PS
exam" from the list.

Mr. Kobashigawa asked the Committee if they wanted to discuss possibly amending the endorsement requirements for architects based on the recent change to NCARB's IDP requirement. With the new IDP requirement of completing 3,740 hours of training in core subjects only, it would be possible for an intern to complete IDP in two years or less, and also with the potential of completing IDP upon graduation. Upon graduation from an accredited program, the intern can start taking the A.R.E. Board of Professional Engineers, Architects, Surveyors and Landscape Architects Minutes of the April 9, 2015 Rules Committee Meeting Page 2

Therefore, it would be possible for a person to obtain a license via exam in a much shorter time than three years which is the requirement for endorsement applicants. After lengthy discussion, the Committee is inclined to maintain the same requirement of three years of lawful experience for endorsement applicants. Moreover, the Committee discussed continuing education ("CE") requirements for professional engineers, surveyors, and landscape architects. Mr. Kurokawa stated that the Hawaii Association of Landscape Architects ("ASLA") is in favor of requiring CE for landscape architects and is currently discussing the issue. Mr. Kobashigawa suggested that the Hawaii ASLA develop the CE requirements they wish to have and make a presentation on the proposal to the Board.
