Officer's Report: as an Executive Officer on July 1, 2014. Mr. Keen has been

assigned as the Executive Officer for the Elevator Mechanics Board. He is currently in training and will be taking over the

Board at a later date.

There was an inquiry regarding the public and industry vacancies. The Executive Officer stated that there has been no word on any nominations for either vacancy. The Chair stated that he would follow up with a licensee who showed interest in applying.

The Chair asked the Executive Officer for clarification on journeyman mechanics. Apparently there has been some misunderstanding and/or misconception regarding what they are allowed to do. A brief discussion followed.

In response to the Chair's request for clarification, the Executive Officer explained that an apprentice mechanic must work under the supervision of a licensed mechanic. The union may have their own interpretation of what a journeyman can do but it is different from the state's laws and rules.

It was noted that temporary permits are only good for three months, and expires at the time the applicant has completed the particular job for which the permit was issued. A temporary permit may also be issued if there is a shortage of licensed elevator mechanics in this state. An applicant with a temporary permit must work under the supervision of a licensed supervisor.
