	<u>27, 2015</u> :		After some discussion, upon a motion by Ms. Chang, seconded by Dr. Au, it was voted on and unanimously carried to approve the minutes of the July 27, 2015 meeting as circulated.

	<u>Officer's</u> <u>Report</u> :		A copy of the proposed 2016 Meeting Schedule was distributed to the Board.		
			EO Matsushima reminded the Board that if they have any conflicts or are unable to attend a scheduled meeting, they should contact the board office as soon as possible.		
		b.	Association of Regulatory Boards of Optometry ("ARBO") Member Executive Director ("ED")/Administrator Committee		
			EO Matsushima reported that she has accepted an invitation to be a member of ARBO's Member ED/Administrator Committee for 2016.		
			She reported that ARBO has requested the Board complete their ARBO 2016 Strategic Plan Stakeholder Input Survey. The Board had a brief discussion regarding their responses to the survey.		
			EO Matsushima also reported the following information:		
			All Hawaii OD licenses must be renewed by December 31, 2015 including providing proof of completing the required continuing education hours. She noted that the Board conducts a continuing education audit of 100% of licensees. She reported that she will be requesting assistance from the Hawaii Optometric Association to inform their members of the upcoming renewal.		
			In the near future, there will be an across the board increase in licensing fees. She noted that there has not been a significant fee increase since 1982. The increase is needed to modernize the functions of the licensing and enforcement divisions.		
			The July 22, 2015 Geographic Report had 426 current OD licenses. 217 on Oahu, 27 on Hawaii Island, 23 on Maui, 10 on Kauai, 147 on the Mainland and 2 in foreign countries.		

> There were no OD disciplinary actions in August and September.

5. Old a. Election of Officers **Business**: Dr. Loo moved to nominate Dr. Saito as Chair. Dr. Au seconded the motion. It was voted on and unanimously carried. Dr. Loo moved to nominate Dr. Shoji as Vice Chair. Ms. Chang seconded the motion. It was voted on and unanimously carried. 6. New a. Regulated Industries Complaints Office ("RICO") Optometry Advisory Committee Business: The Board reviewed a list provided by RICO of optometry advisory committee members effective January 1, 2016 and addendum language which will allow RICO to include any additional interim appointees that they deem necessary to aid in its investigations. After some discussion, upon a motion by Dr. Reynolds, seconded by Dr. Saito, it was voted on and unanimously carried to approve the list provided by RICO for the Optometry Advisory Committee effective January 1, 2016 and the addendum language for the 2016 term. b. Inquiry from Nikki Leon regarding optometrists leasing space from corporations The Board reviewed Ms. Leon's email in which she states "My understanding is that HRS 459-9(4) prevents optometrists from directly or indirectly accepting employment from a company or corporation, but I was unable to find anything in the statutes, rules, or on the department of commerce and consumer affairs website addressing whether optometrists may lease space from a retail corporation. I would like to clarify that there is no prohibition on optometrists leasing space in an optical retail store, as long as the optometrist does not advertise under the corporation's trade name." Executive At 9:14 a.m., it was moved by Dr. Saito, seconded by Ms. Chang, and Session: unanimously carried to move into Executive Session in accordance with HRS, 92-5(a)(4). "To consult with the board's attorney on guestions and issues pertaining to the board's powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities". At 9:35 a.m., it was moved by Dr. Saito, seconded by Dr. Loo, and unanimously carried to move out of Executive Session. After some discussion, upon a motion by Dr. Reynolds, seconded by Dr. Saito, it was voted on and unanimously carried to inform Ms. Leon that upon review of Hawaii's applicable statutes and regulations regarding the practice of Optometry, there appears to be no prohibition on optometrists leasing space in

7. <u>Continuing</u> Education: an optical retail store, as long as the optometrist does not advertise under the corporation's trade name. The Board asked the EO to inform Ms. Leon that there may be other applicable federal or state laws that may prohibit such conduct and suggest that Ms. Leon seek private legal counsel in order to better address the issue.
