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October 12, 2015:

After some discussion, upon a motion by Dr. Loo, seconded by Dr. Reynolds, it was voted on and unanimously carried to approve the minutes of the October 12, 2015 meeting as circulated.

4. Executive Officer's Report:

EO Matsushima reported the following:

- There are 432 Hawaii OD licenses eligible for renewal. As of 11/17/15, 150 licenses have been renewed with 149 of those completed online.
- The West Virginia Board of Optometry inquired whether any other states or jurisdictions are experiencing a problem with illegal sales of contact lenses without a valid prescription. EO Matsushima reported that the Board has not received any complaints.

Chair Saito commented that he believed the American Optometric Association was looking into the issue and they have asked their members to provide documentation/notes and examples.

The Legislature is asking each Board to provide an opinion on whether or not they think the public member representation on their board should be increased.

After some discussion, it was the consensus of the Board that there is no need to increase public member representation.

a. Request from Nora M. Y. Chan, O.D. for Trade Name Approval

The Board reviewed the request from Dr. Chan for trade name approval.

Upon a motion by Dr. Loo, seconded by Dr. Au, it was voted on and unanimously carried to approve Dr. Chan's request for approval of the trade name "Honolulu Vision Care Center".

a. <u>Association of Regulatory Boards of Optometry ("ARBO") OE Tracker Update from</u> Sierra Rice

DAG Jacob reminded the Board that Hawaii Administrative Rules ("HAR") §16-92-40 requires that the continuing education certificates contain specific information, including the signature of lecturer or any authorized official of the sponsoring body.

EO Matsushima noted on the ARBO certificates being submitted for the current license renewal, there is no signature of the lecturer or an authorized official of the sponsoring body, instead, there is an area for the licensee to sign attesting that they attended the course. She will check with Ms. Rice to see if ARBO can add the required signature.

DAG Jacob noted that if the Board wants to change any of the certificate requirements, they would need to amend their rules.
