Hawaii Revised Statutes Chapter 465 Members reviewed the proposed amendments to Hawaii Revised Statutes Chapter 465 ("HRS"). Discussion followed. It was moved by Dr. Adam-Terem, seconded by Mr. Oliphant, and unanimously carried to approve the proposed amendments to HRS § 465-7(a)(1)(A), to read as follows: Every applicant for a license as a psychologist (a) shall submit evidence satisfactory to the board that the applicant meets the following requirements: The applicant for licensure shall possess (1) a doctoral degree from: (A) An American Psychological Association approved program in clinical psychology, counseling psychology, school psychology, or programs offering combinations of two or more of these areas. Members indicated that its administrative rule package must also be updated to reflect the possible statutory changes. Proposed amendments to Hawaii Administrative Rules Chapter 98 New Business: a. This matter was deferred to the September 19, 2014 meeting. Members present indicated that there should be input from those members not in attendance regarding this matter. Correspondence: None.
