Call to Order: There being a quorum present, the meeting was called to order by Chairperson Hashimoto at 1:30 p.m.

The following agenda item was taken out of order.

Legislation: a. House Bill No. 1072, H.D. 1 Relating to Prescriptive Authority for Certain Psychologists

Dr. Oliveira Gray from the Hawaii Psychological Association (“HPA”) was present to discuss House Bill No. 1072, H.D. 1.

Dr. Oliveira Gray indicated that language regarding the exclusionary formulary for prescriptive authority is similar to the language in the Board of Nursing Hawaii Administrative Rules (“HAR”) Chapter 89 section 16-89-122.

She also indicated that the definitions of controlled substance, narcotic drug and opiate were incorporated from the Hawaii

Revised Statutes Chapter 329 Uniform Controlled Substances Act.

Currently there are three clinical psychopharmacology programs designated by the American Psychological Association ("APA"); California School of Professional Psychology (Alliant International University), Fairleigh Dickinson University, and the Southwestern Institute for the Advancement of Psychotherapy/New Mexico State University. The University of Hawaii at Hilo's application for designation is currently under review with APA.

On pages 7 - 8 the revised draft shall read as follows:

"(B) A Clinical experience that will include:
i) A minimum of 400 hours and completed in no less than 12 months and no more than 48 months;"

DAG Wong asked for clarification of the use of the terms "consultation" and "collaboration" as noted on page 10.

Dr. Oliveira Gray answered that supervision of the prescribing psychologist would be done by an APRN Rx. She also answered that the prescribing psychologist would have a collaborative relationship with an APRN or APRN Rx.

DAG Wong suggested that the term "physician of record" be replaced with "primary health care provider".

Dr. Hashimoto suggested that the term APRN should also be included with "physician of record".

DAG Wong asked whether an out of state primary care provider is required to have a Hawaii license. Dr. Oliveira Gray answered in the affirmative.

DAG Wong then suggested that the term "primary care provider" be used instead of "physician of record". The primary care provider must be a MD, DOS, or an APRN with a Hawaii license.

1:45 p.m. Dr. Adam-Terem arrived at the meeting.

Dr. Oliveira Gray asked what title would be used to identify themselves. Members discussed the use of "prescribing psychologist" or "psychologist with prescriptive authority".

After discussion, it was recommended that page 10, §465-__(d)(2) would read as follows:

“Consults with the patient’s physician of record or APRN, regarding making changes to a medication treatment plan, including dosage adjustments or adding or discontinuing a medication; provided that the prescribing psychologist shall document the consultation in the patient’s medical record.”

The Board suggested that the exclusionary formulary be a separate exhibit to the draft.

Dr. Combs stated that the prescribing psychologist may only prescribe medications “only in the treatment of a psychiatric condition”.

On page 11 **Prescriptive authority privilege; exclusionary formulary** to read as follows:

465-__ (b) “The Exclusionary Formulary for prescribing psychologists shall consist of drugs or categories of drugs promulgated by the Board”.

465-__ (d) “The Exclusionary Formulary shall consist of:
(1) Schedule[d] I through III drugs (including all narcotic drugs and opiates) pursuant to sections 329-14, 329-16, 329-18, Hawaii Revised Statutes with the exception of Stimulants for the treatment of Attention deficit hyperactivity disorder.”

Dr. Oliveira Gray left the meeting at 2:24 p.m.

Approval of the Meeting Minutes:

It was moved by Ms. Chun Fat, seconded by Dr. Adam-Terem, unanimously carried to approve the open session and executive session minutes of the October 16, 2015 meeting as circulated.

After discussion, it was moved by Dr. Peter, seconded by Dr. Adam-Terem, and unanimously carried to approve the First Amended Settlement Agreement Prior to Filing of Petition for Disciplinary Action and Board's Final Order in the above case.

Following the Board's review, deliberation and decision in these matters, pursuant to Chapter 91, HRS, Chairperson Hashimoto announced that the Board was reconvening to its open meeting at 2:39 p.m.
