Old Business:

**Collaborative Agreement**

The Chair stated the EO will still be checking with the UH College of Pharmacy to get the students to help the Committee do research and gather information on collaborative agreements. The students are the future of the practice of pharmacy so we would really like for them to play a part in making these changes happen. Chapter 461 has to be looked at and then we have to develop rules for a general category of what a collaborative agreement is and not be specific, but try to keep the statement general. When the immunizations first started we were looking at only influenza, but now pharmacist are administering all kinds of vaccines. The Board has to consider adopting rules under what the requirements are surrounding collaborative agreements, define it. We don't want the Board to have to police it; we want the agreement to be between the pharmacist and the physician, while keeping in mind public safety. The responsibility of the Board is public/consumer safety, not enhancing the practice of pharmacy. The Committee needs to gather all the information and bring to the full Board for them to vote and adopt changes to the rules.

The Chair stated the Committee also needs to further discuss the miscellaneous permit section also. It is important to understand that the Board is receiving numerous questions regarding compounding and medical devices. Statutory amendments may have to be made for miscellaneous permits.

Mr. Lau suggested the discussion of miscellaneous permits should be added to the Committee's next agenda.
