a. Initial 8 Hour Security Guard Training Curricula

(i) United Armored Car Services Initial 8 Hour Security Guard Training Curricula

It was moved by Mr. Chang, seconded by Chief Perry and unanimously carried to defer the approval of United Armored Car Services Initial 8 Hour Security Guard Training Curricula pending receipt of the information being taught in the Aloha Training section.

b. Legislation Update

The Executive Officer informed the Board that Governor Abercrombie signed SB2486HD1,SD1,CD1 or Act 094 on June 16, 2014, to be effective June 29, 2014.

Act 094 (SLH 2014) amends various provisions relating to private guards and individuals acting in a guard capacity by: reducing the continuing education requirement to four hours every two years; delaying the continuing education requirement to prior to the June 30, 2016, renewal cycle; and making permanent the registration and licensure requirements for private guards and individuals acting in a guard capacity by repealing the sunset date of Act 208, Session Laws of Hawaii 2010.

2014 Board
Renewals:

a. Update

The Executive Officer would like to encourage everyone to renew online. Hard copy renewals are touched by many hands which slows the process and must go through an initial review. Any renewals with "Yes" answers must also be reviewed and approved by the Executive Officer or the Board. Online renewal applicants will be updated in the computer by the next business day and an applicant may pull a copy of their renewal receipt for verification until their pocket arrives. More than half of the registered guard employees have renewed their guard cards.

Jeff Owens of Transcend, Inc. informed the Board that he has been encouraging his students to renew online and that he is currently receiving requests for continued competency classes.

Scope:

a. Request for Board's determination if the Department of Civil Service County of Hawaii Security Attendant (SR06; BU 03) position must be in compliance with Act 208.

The Board reviewed Mr. Kamakawiwoole's request as to whether this position is subject to Act 208 and the position job description.
