B. Beauty School License

After discussion, it was moved by Ms. Howard, seconded by Chairperson Marugame, and unanimously carried to defer decision-making on the beauty school application of PAFMO HAWAII INC dba MOE ACADEMY OF AESTHETICS & MASSAGE, to require that the applicant provide clarification and documents relating to the utilization of two separate floor spaces for the beauty school.

After discussion, it was moved by Ms. Howard, seconded by Ms. McKay, and unanimously carried to approve the barber application for examination and license of Aukai R. Kim.

After discussion, it was moved by Ms. Howard, seconded by Ms. McKay, and unanimously carried to approve the barber application for examination and license of Maria C. Rogers.

D. Beauty Shop/Barber Shop License

- (2) Hairstyles by Noe, LLC ( Relocation of Barber Shop )

The seven (7) applications were preliminarily reviewed by staff, the Executive Officer, and Ms. Howard, the designated Board member to review the new and relocation beauty shop and barber shop applications for consideration for this Board meeting. Ms. Howard stated that the applications meet the new requirements for beauty shop and barber shop licenses, and recommended approval.

After discussion, it was moved by Ms. Howard, seconded by Ms. McKay, and unanimously carried to approve barber/beauty shop applications #1 to #7, as listed above.

E. Restoration of Licenses

(1) CHOE, Eun Young Cindy ( BEO-14461 )

After discussion, it was moved by Ms. Howard, seconded by Ms. McKay, and unanimously carried to approve the restoration of the beauty operator's license of Eun Young Cindy Choe.

(2) SIMMONS, Carlissa J. ( BAR-2367 )

After discussion, it was moved by Ms. Howard, seconded by Ms. McKay, and unanimously carried to approve the restoration of the barber's license of Carlissa J. Simmons.

(3) SYMONDS, Luzviminda M. ( BSH-2398 )

After discussion, it was moved by Chairperson Marugame, seconded by Ms. Howard, and unanimously carried to defer decision- making on the application for the restoration of the beauty shop license of Luzviminda M. Symonds, pending the receipt of additional documents relating to the requirements for the restoration of a beauty shop license.

(4) TRAN, Kim Thi ( BEO-11236 )

After discussion, it was moved by Ms. Howard, seconded by Ms. McKay, and unanimously carried to approve the restoration of the beauty operator's license of Kim Thi Tran.

(5) UYEHARA, Cynthia L. ( BSH-3111 )

After discussion, it was moved by Chairperson Marugame, seconded by Ms. Howard, and unanimously carried to defer decision- making on the application for the restoration of the beauty shop license of Cynthia L. Uyehara, pending the receipt of additional documents relating to the requirements for the restoration of a beauty shop license.

Executive  
Officer's Report:

A. Update on the Requirements for Beauty Shop and Barber Shop Licenses - New, Relocations, License Restorations

Executive Officer Kai reiterated that the Board had suggested several clarifications to the Board's procedures for beauty shop and barber shop license applications. She stated that the incorporation of these clarifications in the application forms and instructions was completed and provided the Board members with copies for their review. She reiterated that these requirements would affect new, relocations, and restoration applications.

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Quintana, seconded by Ms. Howard, and unanimously carried to approve the amendments in the application forms and instructions.

Executive Officer Kai reminded the Board that Mr. Nelson had agreed to volunteer to review the barber and beauty shop applications which would be presented for the Board's consideration at its March 12, 2014 meeting. She reminded the Board that they had agreed to volunteer on a rotation basis. After discussion, Chairperson Marugame volunteered to review the barber and beauty shop applications which would be presented for the Board's consideration at its April 7, 2014 meeting, and Mr. Quintana volunteered to review the barber and beauty shop applications which would be presented for the Board's consideration at its May 14, 2014 meeting. Both members were thanked for their service.

B. Beauty Operator's License Requirement for Education Equivalent to the Completion of High School

Executive Officer Kai reported that an inquiry was received from the father of a prospective Honolulu Community College ("HCC") cosmetology program student concerning the high

school education his daughter completed from an online school, Lincoln Academy, that advertises and represents itself as an accredited high school. The HCC Cosmetology program stated that they will accept this student with her online diploma but could not confirm whether the Board, when the student applies for a license, would accept her online education in fulfillment of the education requirement for a beauty operator's license.

Ms. Kai stated that she had responded that the Board's position is that a license applicant must provide verification or a diploma from a high school that is accredited by an entity recognized by the United States Department of Education ("US DOE") or the Hawaii State Department of Education; she could not determine whether Lincoln Academy's accrediting body (National Home School Accreditation of America) was recognized by the US or Hawaii DOE. She further responded that a verification of the accrediting body should be submitted to assist the Board in its decision. Ms. Kai also stated that she mentioned that should his daughter opt to pursue an Associate in Allied Sciences degree from HCC, attainment of this degree would meet the education requirement for a license.

Subsequently, the Board received a letter from the HCC Cosmetology Department requesting advice and guidance from the Board because it does not have a policy regarding this issue, and seeks to avoid any future misunderstandings of what is required. Raising questions such as who is responsible for the authenticity of the high school diploma or its equivalent? Is it the applicant, the cosmetology school or the Board.

Per HCC's catalog, HCC "welcomes applications from any U.S. high school graduate, GED (General Education Development) recipient, or persons 18 years of age or over who can benefit from the instruction offered." The catalog also states that some programs have non-academic prerequisites that must be met before taking major courses: Cosmetology – submit copy of high school diploma, GED, or college degree.

After discussion, it was moved by Ms. Howard, seconded by Ms. McKay, and unanimously carried to defer further discussion on the matter pending input and guidance from the HCC Cosmetology Department. Further, the motion instructed the Executive Officer to draft a letter from the Board

requesting the assistance and guidance of the HCC Cosmetology Department in this matter.

C. Request for Waiver of Late Renewal Penalty from Genya Scroggin ( BEO 13828 )

After discussion, it was moved by Ms. McKay, seconded by Ms. Howard, and unanimously carried to deny the request for waiver of late renewal penalty from Genya Scroggin.

A. Barber Examinations Administered in September 2013 and December 2013

Executive Officer Kai provided the following results of the barber examinations administered in September 2013 and December 2013:

Executive Officer Kai provided the following results of the cosmetology examinations administered in October 2013 and December 2013:

Scope of Practice: A. Use of Light and Heat ("LHE") Devices

Chairperson Marugame commented that he had consulted with a dermatologist who mentioned the side effects from the use of LHE devices, such as burning of the skin. After discussion, the consensus of the Board was to defer the matter pending further research. Chairperson Marugame volunteered to look further into the issue and report back to the Board.

B. Chemical Peels

Ms. Howard commented that she will research chemical peels and report back to the Board; thus the consensus of the Board was to defer the matter pending further research.
