- a. In the Matter of the Chiropractor License of Michael B. Roth, D.C., CHI 2012-4-L, Settlement Agreement After Filing of Petition for Disciplinary Action and Board's Final Order.

After discussion, it was moved by Dr. Pleiss, seconded by Ms. Kikuta, and unanimously carried to accept the Settlement Agreement After Filing of Petition for Disciplinary Action and Board's Final Order.

Correspondence:

- A. September 17, 2013 email from American Chiropractic Association Re: New Informed Consent Resources for DC's.

Board members were provided a copy of the email which shared information to help chiropractors foster a shared decision making with their patients through the informed consent process.

The Board requested to disseminate this information to the Hawaii Chiropractic Association ("HCA"). Executive Officer Bhanot will follow-up and contact the HCA.

B. October 1, 2013 email from Kristal Langner Re: Chiropractic First Aid/CPR requirements.

Kristal Langner is seeking Hawaii requirements regarding Chiropractors training requirements for First Aid and/or CPR. After further discussion, Dr. Klein indicated that there is no such requirements for Chiropractors.

The Board informally opined HRS Chapter 442 and Hawaii Administrative Rules ("HAR") Chapter 76 do not specifically address chiropractors training requirements for First Aid and/or CPR.

In accordance with HAR section 16-201-90, the above interpretation is for informational and explanatory purposes only. It is not an official opinion or decision, and thus, is not to be viewed as binding on the Board.

C. October 1, 2013 email from Suzanne Schiller, D.C. Re: Scope of Practice.

Dr. Schiller is asking the Board whether internal pelvic floor myofascial release techniques (vaginal and/or rectal), proprioceptive re-education, and neuromuscular rehabilitation is within the Chiropractic scope of practice.

Pending further review and discussion, the Board did not determine whether the proposed conduct constitutes the practice of Chiropractic as defined in section 442-1 of the HRS.
