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Legislation: a. <u>Senate Bill No. 2577, S.D. 2, H.D. 2, C.D. 1 Relating to</u> Naturopathic Physicians

At the Board's March 14, 2014 meeting it supported the continuing education requirement as proposed in Senate Bill No. 2577, S.D. 2. and approved a 100% audit of its licensees.

The House Committee on Consumer Protection and Commerce held a decision making hearing on April 2, 2014 regarding the above measure. The measure was passed with amendments in H.D. 2.

The Conference Committee meeting was held on April 21, 2014. The measure was passed as C.D. 1.

The above measure was enrolled to the Governor on May 2, 2014 as Senate Bill No. 2577, S.D. 2, H.D. 2, C.D. 1.

Members discussed whether the measure will require changes to the Hawaii Administrative Rules Chapter 88. After discussion, it was determined that rules changes will not be required as the measure, if signed into law, will be implemented into Hawaii Revised Statutes Chapter 455.

Members also discussed whether the measure will have a fiscal impact on the Department of Commerce and Consume Affairs. After discussion, it was determined that there will be a fiscal impact with an increase in staff and board members hours in reviewing and approving 100% of licensees being audited every biennium.
