Old Business: Motorcycle Mechanic Exam As a result of a meeting with HCC in August 2015, it was determined by HCC that the November 2010 HCC exam, answer keys and scores stand as reviewed by their staff and an impartial outside source (HPD). It is unclear if they considered DCCA's concerns. The Executive Officer presented options for the future of motorcycle licensing: 1) continue using the current exam; 2) hire a new entity to develop, implement and score a new motorcycle exam; or 3) delete the motorcycle exam requirement in the rules.
