Agenda: The agenda for this meeting was filed with the Office of the Lieutenant Governor as required by Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") section 92-7.

A brief video regarding the virtual board meeting, including meeting procedures and helpful information regarding how members of the public can participate and interact with the board during the meeting, was played.

Call to Order: There being a quorum present, the meeting was called to order at 10:33 a.m. by Chair Denis.

Vice-Chair Inouye, Chief Ferreira, Mr. Collins, Mr. Chu and Chair Dennis confirmed they were present.

Approval of the Board Minutes: Chair Denis asked if there were any corrections to the November 17, 2021 open session minutes and executive session minutes.

It was moved by Vice-Chair Inouye, seconded by Mr. Collins, and unanimously carried to approve the open session and executive session minutes of the November 17, 2021 meeting.

Executive Session: At 10:37 a.m., it was moved by Vice-Chair Inouye, seconded by Chair Denis, and unanimously carried to move into executive session pursuant to HRS §92-5 to consider and evaluate personal information relating to individuals applying for professional or vocational licenses cited in section HRS §26-9 or both, and to consult with the board's attorney on questions and issues pertaining to the board's powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities, as provided in HRS §92-5(a)(1) and (4).

EXECUTIVE SESSION

At 10:48 a.m., it was moved by the Vice-Chair Inouye seconded by Mr. Collins and unanimously carried to move out of executive session.

Applications: A. Guard Employees

1. Douglas Campbell

After due consideration of the information received, it was moved by Mr. Collins, seconded by Vice-Chair Inouye and unanimously carried to approve Douglas Campbell's application for licensure subject to certain conditions:

The Board based its decision on the following citation of the Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS"), which finds factual support in the records and files of Mr. Campbell's application:

HRS section 436B-19 provides that;

In addition to any other acts or conditions provided by law, the licensing authority may refuse to renew, reinstate or restore, or may deny revoke, suspend, or condition in any manner, any license for any one or more of the following acts or conditions on the part of the licensee of the applicant thereof:

* * *

(1) Failure to meet or maintain the conditions and requirements necessary to qualify for the granting of a license;

For reasons contained in the records and files of Mr. Campbell's application, the Board placed the following conditions on his conditional licenses:

1. Mr. Campbell shall comply with all of the terms and conditions of his probation.
 - a. Mr. Campbell shall provide the Board with semiannual progress reports from his probation officer. For the semiannual periods of January to June; and July to December; the progress report shall be due on or before July 31st and January 31st respectively. The progress reports shall indicate whether Mr. Campbell is complying with the terms and conditions of his probation.
 - b. Upon completion of his terms, Mr. Campbell shall submit proof of discharge to the Board; and if his probation is amended in any way or is revoked:
 - c. Mr. Campbell shall report any such amendment or revocation to the Board within thirty (30) calendar days of the amendment or revocation; and
 - d. If Mr. Campbell fails to timely notify the Board of such amendment or revocation, this conditional registration shall be automatically revoked without a hearing on the 30th day after the date of the amendment or the date his probation was revoked, as applicable;
2. Mr. Campbell shall submit an annual FBI national criminal history record check and State of Hawaii criminal history record check from the Hawaii Criminal Justice Data Center ("**criminal abstracts**") to the Board.
 - a. These criminal abstracts shall be due on January 31 of each year and shall cover the periods of January to December.
 - b. In order to obtain these criminal abstracts, Mr. Campbell shall be fingerprinted electronically at Fieldprint Inc. at his own cost and expense, and

3. Mr. Campbell shall refrain from any actions that may result in his arrest or conviction for any crimes against persons or property (including but not limited to theft, burglary, assault, etc.) or any other act that is directly related to the guard profession.
 - a. Mr. Campbell shall report any such arrests or convictions to the Board within thirty (30) calendar days of the arrests or convictions, and
 - b. If Mr. Campbell fail to timely notify the Board of such arrests or convictions, this conditional registration shall be automatically revoked without a hearing on the 30th day after the date of the arrests or convictions.

2. Jeffrey Silva

After due consideration of the information received, it was moved by Mr. Collins, seconded by Vice-Chair Inouye and unanimously carried to approve Jeffrey Silva's application for licensure subject to certain conditions:

The Board based its decision on the following citation of the Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS"), which finds factual support in the records and files of Mr. Campbell's application:

HRS section 436B-19 provides that;

In addition to any other acts or conditions provided by law, the licensing authority may refuse to renew, reinstate or restore, or may deny revoke, suspend, or condition in any manner, any license for any one or more of the following acts or conditions on the part of the licensee of the applicant thereof:

Uniform Review:

It was moved by Vice-Chair Inouye, seconded by Mr. Collins, and unanimously carried, to approve the following uniform submission:

1. Surefox North America (GDA)

2022 Legislative
Session:

A. HB 1240/ SB 781 RELATING TO LAW ENFORCEMENT

The Board discussed the above bill.

The purposes of the bill are to: authorize forfeiture of certain employees’ retirement system benefits for law enforcement officers who are convicted of an employment-related crime, require law enforcement officers under investigation for a felony offense to be placed on unpaid administrative leave, and if convicted, be permanently barred from employment as a law enforcement officer, private detective, or guard.

EO Fukunaga requested the Board’s position on this bill.

Mr. Collins expressed concern that former law enforcement officers (“LEO”) who were convicted of a felony would be permanently prohibited from being a private detective or guard. Mr. Collins stated that the Board has previously approved applicants with substantial priors who have demonstrated that they have been sufficiently rehabilitated. Mr. Collins commented that the Board should be standardized in its approach on reviewing applications.

Chief Ferreira remarked that he had interpreted the language of the bill to mean that the preclusion of private detective or guard licensure applied only to LEOs who have been convicted of a felony offence in the capacity of their employment.

DAG Leong commented that:

- Section 2, page 4, lines 16 through 19, states, “A crime is “related to the employment” of a law enforcement officer if the law enforcement officer uses or attempts to use the officer’s official position to commit the crime”
- Section 3, page 6, lines 6 through 10, states, “The board shall revoke the license of any licensee who has been convicted in any jurisdiction of a felony offense while employed as a law enforcement officer and permanently bar the licensee from obtaining a license under this chapter.”

DAG Leong stated that the language regarding a crime related to the employment of a law enforcement officer appears to only apply to the retirement benefits forfeiture section of the bill. However, the language amending Chapter 463 prohibits licensure for any felony offense.

DAG Leong advised that the Board could provide testimony to have Chapter 463 removed from the bill. Alternatively, the Board could provide comments to clarify the language in Section 3, page 6, lines 6 through 10, and request amendments to make the language consistent with other sections of the bill.

Chief Ferreira commented that Chapter 463 should be removed from the bill entirely and leave it to the Board to make their own determination.

Mr. Collins agreed with Chief Ferreira, adding that LEOs have a specific skill set that would be an asset to the industry.

Although no hearing has been scheduled, it was moved by Mr. Collins, seconded by Chief Ferreira, and unanimously carried to oppose the sections that amend Hawaii Revised Statutes (“HRS”) Chapter 463.
