Program of Work: Rulemaking, Chapter 107

The Blue Ribbon Panel members have been sent an initial draft of the proposed rules and asked to meet at least once a month for the next four to six months to discuss recommendations that each may have for proposed rules to implement Chapter 514B, HRS.

Government and Legislative Participation & Report

Specialist Yee reported on the status of the following bills:

HB 2017 – Relating to condominiums. Clarifies the applicability of section 205-4.6, HRS, relating to private restrictions on agricultural uses and activities to condominium projects on lands classified as agricultural. The measure House Agriculture Committee deferred the measure. Its companion, SB 2078 is still alive and has passed with amendments.

HB 2401 – Relating to condominiums. Requires condominium board members and managing agents to disclose potential conflicts of interest in the awarding of contracts. Requires annual report on complaints and enforcement actions. Grants the real estate commission enforcement powers over issues relating to the management of condominiums. The measure passed second reading with amendments as HD1. The current amendment appears to revive condo court. Its companion bill SB 2363 has been deferred.

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	Chair Sherley noted that HB 1923 required resident managers to keep a record of the email addresses of condominium association members. Discussion followed about the possible relation between the Commission's decision on a recent request for an informal non-binding interpretation of section 514A-83.3, HRS.
