ORDER

On March 15, 1985, the Hearings Officer's Recommended Decision was received by the Director of Commerce and Consumer Affairs ("Director") and served on the parties. Kohala Cable Television ("Kohala") filed timely exceptions to the Recommended Decision with the Director on April 2, 1985, and Kam Cablevision Co. ("Kam") filed a statement in support of the Recommended Decision on April 8, 1985.

Having carefully considered the Recommended Decision, Kohala's exceptions, Kam's statement in support, and other pertinent information in this case, the Director believes that additional information should be obtained prior to the rendering of a final decision in this matter. The Director notes that the parties agreed at the hearing held September 6, 1985 that the North Kohala district could not support two separate and overlapping cable television systems. The Director further notes that Kohala stated that it would consult the principals of Kam regarding the matter if permits were issued to both applicants.

It is hereby ordered that this proceeding be remanded to the Hearings Officer to investigate whether Kohala and Kam could jointly operate a single cable television system in the North Kohala district.
