8. MISCELLANEOUS

a. Relocation, Reassignment, and Reconnection Charges.

1. The relocation of a service drop on a subscribers premises is subject to a reconnection charge of \$27.50. (I)
2. The reassignment of a service drop where no disconnection or reconnection is involved is subject to a reassignment charge of \$5.50. (I)
3. A service drop that has been disconnected at the request of the subscriber or which has been disconnected for non-payment is subject to a reconnection charge of \$16.50. (I)

b. Vacation Rates - (Schedule D-1 Only) (T)

1. Minimum period for schedule to apply - Thirty (30) days.
2. Vacation Rate - 50% of regular monthly service charge.

c. Extra Outlet Charges. (T)

1. Since the installation of more than two (?) outlets in a single unit will seriously degrade the signal due to splitter and cable losses the installation of an amplifier may be required. The installation charge for such an amplifier, in addition to the applicable connection charge(s), will be based on time and materials and a deposit equal to the cost of the amplifier will be required which is refundable upon termination of service less any service charges required to effect such repairs as may be deemed necessary.
