On August 4, 1981, in Cable Order No. 83 the Director of Regulatory Agencies granted The Seventy Twenty Limited Partnership authority to provide cable communication services to Census Tract Nos. 401, 407, 408, 409 and parts of Census Tract Nos. 402 and 406, subject to certain conditions. Condition No. 8 of the said Order required "the limited partnership shall, prior to the beginning of subscriber service, submit for approval by the Director of Regulatory Agencies a tariff setting forth the terms, conditions and charges for cable services to the designated service area. The original findings shall be consistent with representations set forth in the application."

Upon review and consideration of the tariff dated August 25, 1982 submitted by The Seven Twenty Limited Partnership, the Director of Commerce and Consumer Affairs finds that the said tariff satisfies the above-stated Condition No. 8 of Order No. 83 and does hereby approve the said tariff of terms, conditions and charges for cable services to the above-mentioned service area.
