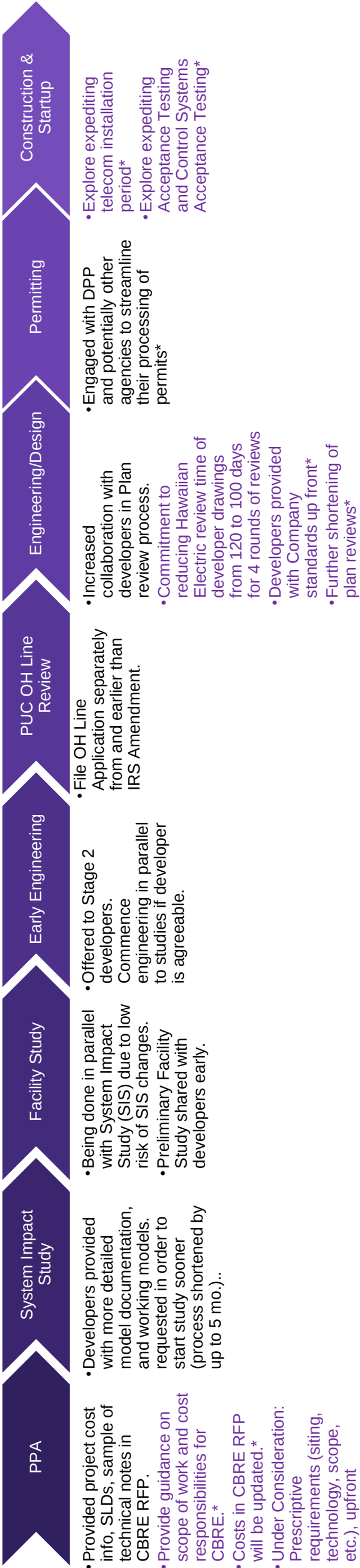

Contingency Actions – Status Update

Contingency Plan	Status Update
Stage 1 and Stage 2 Projects	Ongoing. Working with developers and others to accelerate schedules
60 MW Grid Services RFP (Phase 3)	3/9: CA filing - no comments on draft RFP at this time. No other parties/stakeholders filed comments. Next step: awaiting Commission guidance.
Install 20 MW, 4-hour battery tied to Hawaiian Electric's West Loch PV facility	General Order No. 7 Application can be prepared and filed within three weeks. Can be in-service within 18 months of Commission approval.
Lease 20 MW of batteries and tie to the West Loch PV facility during the lease period.	
Maintenance Outage Adjustments	Adjusting in 2022 and 2023 timeframes
Reactivate Honolulu 8 and/or Honolulu 9	Will require 6 months to resume operations
Extend operation of Waiau 3 and/or Waiau 4
