LĀNA'I BARGE ARRIVAL DELAYED UPDATE NO. 1 SAILING SCHEDULE UPDATE

Dear Valued Customer,

As previously stated, on Wednesday, January 24, 2024, Young Brothers' *KRS 286-6* barge could not enter Kaumalapau harbor safely due to poor ocean conditions. Surge in the harbor continues to persist at the Port of Kaumalapau. As such, our second attempt to enter Kaumalapau harbor for a recovery sailing today, Sunday, January 28, 2024, was unsuccessful, despite use of a harbor assist tug from the island of Maui. The barge will continue to the island of Moloka'i, as scheduled, without discharging in Lāna'i.

A recovery plan is under review, however, ocean conditions this week are forecasted to be unfavorable, and we expect these conditions may impact sailing departures and arrivals at affected ports. We remain dedicated to providing steady interisland cargo services to you, while we navigate weather conditions with safety in mind for our employees.

There are no cargo restrictions at this time and Young Brothers will be making every effort to complete sailings as scheduled; however, changes in the forecast and intensity of the winds and/or ocean conditions could have additional effects on our operation.
