

HILO BARGE DELAYED THURSDAY, MARCH 7, 2024

Dear Valued Customer,

Due to unfavorable weather conditions, our barge, the *Kukahi*, which was expected to arrive in Hilo this morning at 7:00 a.m., has been delayed. The barge's arrival into Hilo is now estimated at 1:00 p.m. For customer convenience, the port of Hilo will have extended gate hours until 6:00 p.m. for the pickup of dry and refrigerated straightload equipment only. Cargo availability is as follows:

- Dry and refrigerated straightload containers: Upon Discharge
- Refrigerated loose and palletized cargo: Friday, March 8, 2024, at 7:30 a.m.
- Dry palletized cargo: Friday, March 8, 2024, at 7:30 a.m.
- Mixed cargo: Friday, March 8, 2024, at 7:30 a.m.
- Automobiles and Roll-on Roll-off Cargo: Upon Notification.

There are no changes to cargo acceptance at the Port of Hilo. All Honolulu bound cargo from Hilo will be available for pick up at the Port of Honolulu on Monday, March 11, 2024, at 7:30 a.m. Dry mixed cargo will be available for pickup on Tuesday, March 12, 2024.
