



BARGE ARRIVAL DELAYED INTO HONOLULU FROM THE PORTS OF KAUMALAPAU & KAUNAKAKI Update No. 2

Dear Valued Customer,

Our barge, the *KRS 286*, which was expected to arrive in Honolulu from the Ports of Kaumalapau and Kaunakakai on Thursday April 4, 2024, was delayed due to a mechanical issue with our towing tug. Our team worked through the mechanical issue with the tug and the barge is underway, estimated to arrive in Honolulu this afternoon. Cargo availability is as follows:

- Dry and refrigerated straightload containers: Monday, April 8, 2024, upon discharge
- Refrigerated loose and palletized cargo: Monday, April 8, 2024, at 7:30 a.m.
- Dry palletized cargo: Monday, April 8, 2024, at 7:30 a.m.
- Mixed cargo: Tuesday, April 9, 2024, at 7:30 a.m.
- Automobiles and Roll-on Roll-off Cargo: Upon notification
