Procedural Reminders for Hurricane Dora and Wildfires

On August 8, 2023, Acting Governor Sylvia Luke proclaimed a state of emergency due to Hurricane Dora and the Wildfires.

If any state-chartered financial institution or state-licensed company finds it necessary to close any office as a precaution for an emergency, you may telephone or email a brief notice to this office in order to fulfill your statutory obligations under the various statutory chapters 412, 454F, 454M, 489D, 449, and 480J, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

If the staff and employees of any state-chartered financial institution or statelicensed company have evacuated, please get in contact with this office as soon as possible to report your new contact information for customers and regulators and the status of your institution.

In the event a state-chartered financial institution or state-licensed company suffers a whole or partial loss of its main office, branch, agency office, or principal office due to Hurricane Dora and the Wildfires, it is NOT necessary to seek the prior approval of this office in order to establish a temporary location. Notice must be given to the Commissioner after-the-fact, of the creation of the temporary location and its address.
