

**For New Surplus Lines Broker (SLB) Applicant** – Pursuant to Hawaii Revised Statute (“HRS”) §431:8-310(f), the business entities shall be eligible to be surplus lines broker, upon meeting the following conditions:

- (1) The business entity licensee shall list individuals within the business entity who have satisfied all requirements of this part to become surplus lines brokers;*
- (2) Only those individuals listed on the business entity's license shall transact surplus lines business; and*
- (3) A natural person licensed as a surplus lines broker shall be identified as the business entity's designated representative.*

In order for the license to be issued, the business entity must provide the Licensing Branch the following requirement via NIPR’s attachment Warehouse at <https://nipr.com/licensing-center/attachments> along with the online application. Please use additional page as necessary. Your application may be considered “rejected” if Licensing Branch does not receive the document below within 7 days from the date the application is submitted. No refund for the fee.
