Chair's Report: Announcements/Introductions

The Chair introduced the Board's new Kauai member Tammie Napoleon and asked her to say a few words.

Ms. Napoleon stated she is from Kauai where she works as an associate professor at Kauai Community College and she just became their Division Chair this year. She has been a pediatric nurse practitioner since 2009 and has probably worked in every type of healthcare you could think of so she could remain on Kauai.

The Chair appointed Ms. Napoleon to the Education Committee and informed her that the Committee meets every odd-numbered month following the regular Board meeting.

The EO explained that Ms. Napoleon is an interim appointment and must be confirmed by the Senate before the close of the 2016 Legislative Session.

- 2. The Committee reviewed a first page draft of a proposed newsletter for the Board and made recommendations.

2016 Legislature - Status Report

The Board members were provided with a copy of "The Legislative Timetables and the Legislative Process" so they have a better understanding of the legislative process.

HB 2331/SB 2860 - Relating to Board Member Terms for the Board of Nursing

The EO reported HB 2331 HD 1 was referred to the Health and Consumer Protection & Commerce Committees. It passed the Health Committee with technical amendments. There is a hearing scheduled today at 5:00 pm. with the Consumer Protection & Commerce Committee. SB 2860 was referred to the Consumer Protection & Commerce Committee.

HB 2332/SB 2861 – Relating to the Joint Formulary Advisory Committee

The EO reported HB 2332 was referred to the Health and Consumer Protection & Commerce Committees. There is a hearing with the Health Committee scheduled 2/12/16 at 8:30 a.m. SB 2861 was referred to the Commerce, Consumer Protection and Health and Ways and Means Committees. It passed the Commerce, Consumer Protection and Health Committee with technical amendments.

HB 2333/SB 2862 – Relating to Nursing (Nursys)

The EO reported HB 2333 was referred to the Consumer Protection & Commerce and Judiciary Committees. SB 2862 was referred to the Commerce, Consumer Protection and Health Committee.

HB 1755/SB 2672 – Relating to Advanced Practice Registered Nurses

The EO reported HB 1755 was referred to the Health, Consumer Protection & Commerce and Finance Committees. It passed the Health Committee unamended. SB 2672 was referred to the Commerce, Consumer Protection and Health Committee.

HB 1756/SB 2677 - Relating to Nursing (CBC)

The EO reported HB 1756 was referred to the Health, Consumer Protection & Commerce and Judiciary Committees. It passed the Health Committee with amendments. There is a hearing scheduled with the Consumer Protection & Commerce Committee today at 5:00 p.m. SB 2677 was referred to the Commerce, Consumer Protection and Health, Judiciary and Labor and Commerce, Consumer Protection and Health Committees. It passed the Commerce, Consumer Protection and Health Committee with amendments.

In our testimony we did ask for a delayed implementation date.

Report on Status of Nursing Related Bills

The EO reported SB 805, that removes the sunset provision from Act 255, SLH 2012, relating to the definitions of "the practice of nursing as a licensed practical nurse" and "the practice of nursing as a registered nurse", which was a carryover from last year was heard by the Consumer Protection & Commerce Committee on 2/8/16. The decision making was yesterday but the EO was unable to attend so she does not know what happened.

There are a few other bills that are being monitored only.

The EO stated if you go onto the Legislative webpage, you can put in the bill numbers and check the status and read committee reports, etc.

The Board was provided with a proposed draft at the last meeting. The EO asked the Board to review it carefully and to provide her with any comments/changes by the next meeting.

Continuing Competency Program

The EO stated she has not received any request recently, however we need to start working on a list of approved providers that can be made available on the Board's webpage.

The EO also commented that nurses continue to rank #1 in the 2015 Gallup Poll in the Honesty and Ethical ratings.

Hawaii State Center for Nursing:

The EO stated she spoke with Ms. Reichhardt yesterday who is extremely busy with the nursing and nursing related bills, and therefore could not attend today's meeting.

<u>Correspondence</u>: How Many Theoretical Hours Are Required for RN?

The Board reviewed an email asking how many maternity and infant theoretical hours are required for RN licensure.

The Chair suggested referring this inquiry to the Education Committee so they can come up with a recommended minimum number of hours required.

The Board by consensus referred this inquiry to the Education Committee for their review and recommendation.

Old Business: Scope of Practice Guidance Document

The EO stated she is still working on this and asked that it be deferred.
