Approval of the Previous Minutes – May 5, 2016

The Chair called for a motion in regards to the minutes of the May 5, 2016 meeting.

There being no discussion, upon a motion by the Vice Chair, seconded by Ms. Napoleon, it was voted on and unanimously carried to approve the minutes of the May 5, 2016 meeting as circulated.

Vice Chair's Report:

The Vice Chair reported on the May 5, 2016 Education Committee meeting as follows:

Executive Officer's Report:

Conferences/Seminars/Meetings

2016 IT/Operations Conference, May 24-25, 2016, Chicago, Illinois

The EO asked the Vice Chair to provide a brief report.

The Vice Chair reported the meeting was very interesting. She found the fraud detection toolkit very useful. They did some exercises by looking at transcripts and letters that point out potentially fraudulent information. The second day she attended three showcases: Nursys Update, The ORBS Hive and Nurse Licensure Compact. She offered the brochure from the meeting to anyone who wanted to review it.

2016 NCSBN Discipline Case Management Conference, June 6-8, 2016, Norfolk, Virginia

The EO reported the DAG Shari Wong will be attending.

2016 NCSBN Annual Meeting, August 17-19, 2016, Chicago, Illinois

The EO stated that the Chair and herself would be attending and asked if anyone was interested in attending.

Mr. Joslyn stated that he was interested.

Board Member Orientation, August 30, 2016. 8:30 a.m. – 12:30 p.m., State Capital Auditorium

The EO reported the Department puts on a Board member orientation every other year. Anyone who has never attended or who may need a refresher course can attend. They will talk about ethics, disciplinary actions, sunshine law and other things a Board member needs to know. The deadline to respond if you want to attend is August 15, 2016.

International Nurse Regulator Collaborative Symposium, October 4-5, 2016, Chicago, Illinois

The EO reported that Ms. Napoleon will be attending.

2016 NCSBN Scientific Symposium, October 6, 2016, Chicago, Illinois

The EO reported that Ms. Napoleon will be attending.

2016 Legislature – Status Report

The EO reported on the following bills:

HB 2331, HD1 (Act 8, SLH 2016) - Relating to Board Member Terms for the Board of Nursing

This bill was signed into law that would extend the terms of the Board of Nursing members from 3 to 4 years.

The EO stated that she will be sending a letter to the Governor's Office confirming the terms of all the current Board members.

SB 2861, SD2, HD1 – Relating to the Joint Formulary Advisory Committee

This bill was enrolled to the Governor's Office on May 3, 2016 that would repeal the Joint Formulary Advisory Committee ("JFAC").

The EO stated that she will be including additional amendments to the current draft she is working on to HAR Chapter 89 to delete any reference to the JFAC.

SB 2862 – Relating to Nursing (Nursys)

This bill was approved by the Governor, Act 18, SLH 2016 that allows the Board to "fully" participate in Nursys.

The EO stated that she and the DAG are reviewing the NCSBN Nursys agreement and while attending the NCSBN Annual Meeting, will be meeting with Nur and his staff as to how the license information can be transferred from our license database to Nursys.

SB 2672, SD1, HD1 – Relating to Advanced Practice Registered Nurses

This bill was enrolled to the Governor's Office on May 9, 2016.

HB 1756, HD3, SD2 – Relating to Nursing (Criminal Background Checks)

This bill was transmitted to the Governor's Office on May 5, 2016.

HB 2707, HD1, SD2, CD1 – Relating to Medical Marijuana

This bill was transmitted to the Governor's Office on May 5, 2016.

The EO stated that this bill would allow APRNs with prescriptive authority to qualify patients for medical marijuana.

SB 2675, SD1, HD2 (Act 28, SLH 2016) – Relating to Licensing

This bill 1) Authorizes the Board of Dental Examiners, Hawaii Medical Board and the Board of Pharmacy to deny a license to an applicant who has been disciplined by another state or federal agency and the **Board of Nursing** to deny a license to an applicant who has been disciplined by another state; 2) Authorizes the Boards previously mentioned to impose disciplinary action against a licensee who was disciplined by another state or federal agency; 3) Establishes conditions for the disciplinary action; 4) Prohibits a licensee from practicing until a final order of discipline is issued if disciplinary action taken by another state prohibited the licensee from practicing in that state; and 5) Ensure consumer protection by requiring any final order of discipline taken to be public record.

Amendments to Title 16, Chapter 89 – Status Report

The EO reported that she is waiting for a "clean" draft from ASO as there were some "issues" with the format.

Continuing Competency Program

The EO reported that she is working on a time table for the dissemination of information. She stated that if too much information is given now, the licensees may get confused. She is working on recommendations for the Board's consideration.

Mr. Joslyn recommended an email blast be sent to the licensees. He also asked if the Hawaii State Center for Nursing could do a mailing?

The EO stated that PVL will be mailing a postcard to licensees directing them to our webpage

The Chair recommended sending out information to Hawaii Nurses Association so they can pass the information on to their members.

The EO stated that she was also thinking of mailing information to DOH licensed facilities that utilize nurses.

The Chair recommended providing information to the nursing programs as well.

Hawaii State
Center for Nursing:

The EO reported that Ms. Reichhardt would not be available today and would be present at the July meeting.

Correspondence:

Article “Telemedicine advocates lobby for nurse licensing compacts: 6 things to know”

The Board reviewed an article regarding nursing licensure compacts that refers to the Nurse Licensure Compact and how hospitals are in favor of this multistate license but unions contend that such “compacts” threaten patient safety since states have different licensing standards.

Use of Complimentary Therapies – Mindy Johnson

The Board discussed an email from Ms. Johnson, a nursing student at the University of Wisconsin currently studying nursing’s use of complimentary therapy at the bedside and after reviewing Hawaii’s nurse practice act, would like to encourage the Board to add an addendum in regards to the use of Complimentary Therapy and Holistic Nursing.

The EO stated this had come up before, and after reviewing the list of nurse practitioner specialties, this comes up as a secondary specialty. However in order to obtain an APRN license the national certification must be for a nurse practitioner or clinical nurse specialist.

Mr. Joslyn stated he is actually a little confused by this inquiry if she is asking that this be an APRN subspecialty. Because in the email it states that this is a bachelor’s degree not a Master’s degree and right away that eliminates APRN status.

The Chair stated anyone can get an additional specialty in holistics, but you cannot get an APRN license with this specialty.

After some discussion, the Board determined that all nurses are encouraged to obtain additional and ongoing training in whatever specialty and/or practice they choose, however, in respect for APRN licensure, the national certification must be for a “nurse practitioner” or “clinical nurse specialist”.

APRN Doing X-Rays?

The Board discussed an inquiry asking if an APRN can perform x-rays.

The EO reported that her research indicated that the DOH “regulates” facilities and individuals related to x-rays and asked if x-rays was a basic nursing task.

The Chair stated performing x-rays is not a basic nursing task.

It was the consensus of the Board that performing x-rays was not a basic nursing task and that even with the appropriate education and training, a nurse would have to meet the requirements of the DOH in order to perform x-rays.

Telephonic Nursing

The Board reviewed an inquiry from Nancy Robinson, Manager of Training and Compliance, EagleOne Case Management Solutions, Inc. in which she stated that they handle workers compensation claims and assist injured workers telephonically with the following: set-up post injury therapy, schedule testing, such as MRI's, EMG's, CT's, etc, assist in approvals, preparation and scheduling of work relating injury surgeries.

The EO stated that she was going to inform Ms. Robinson that if the patient is residing in this State, then the out-of-state nurse who is performing nursing task(s) over the phone would be required to hold a Hawaii nurse license. However, upon review of the activities indicated in Ms. Robinson's email, the EO questions whether these activities needed to be performed by a nurse and/or if these activities are considered nursing task(s).

The Vice Chair stated that it doesn't appear that the nurse is performing any kind of assessment or diagnosis.

After some discussion, it was the consensus of the Board that based solely on the information provided, it does not appear that the activities indicated were dedicated nursing tasks that could only be performed by a licensed nurse as there does not appear to be any assessment of the patient but more of a scheduling task. Furthermore, the Board also would advise Ms. Robinson that if an out-of-state nurse is performing telehealth with someone residing in this State, which is defined as "the use of electronic information and telecommunication technologies to support long-distance clinical health care, patient and professional health-related education, public health and health administration, to the extent that it relates to nursing", then the out-of-state nurse would be required to have a current Hawaii nurse license.
