Approval of the Previous Minutes – September 1, 2016

The Vice Chair called for a motion in regards to the minutes of the September 1, 2016 meeting.

Education Committee Report/Recommendations of September 1, 2016 Meeting

The Vice Chair reported on the following:

Education Committee Report/Recommendations of 9/1/16 Meeting

Hawaii Nursing Programs:

1. Revisions to Program/Curriculum
 - a. Kapiolani Community College – Notice of proposed revision to LPN Certificate of Achievement, pending ACEN accreditation – Recommendation is to approve

Correspondence

1. The Committee reviewed an inquiry about placing a BSN student from the University of Jamestown in Maui for a clinical capstone preceptorship - It was the consensus of the Committee that placing a pre-license BSN student from an out-of-state nursing program in Hawaii to complete clinicals is not allowed.

Old Business:

1. National Council for State Authorization Reciprocity Agreements (SARA) - The Committee reviewed information about the National Council for State Authorization Reciprocity Agreements (SARA). SARA is increasing administrative efficiency and lowering the costs of obtaining authorization to provide postsecondary distance education in states that join.

Continuing Competency

1. The Committee heard from Ms. Smith, a DNP candidate at UH Hilo working closely with Ms. Daub on a project inquiry practicum this year. To complete that, she wanted to speak with the Committee on potential structure that they could use for monitoring the continuing education credits that will be required by the State. One of her goals is to assist the Board with finding different methods or structures that could help streamline the process of monitoring CE requirements. One of the things she understands that has been brought to the table include utilizing some of the criteria that are being met by nationally accredited boards and not necessarily looking at single courses of study. She believes the intent is to create a comprehensive list of those nationally recognized boards and she would like to assist in doing that.

The EO stated the exemption for nationally certified LPNs and RNs would probably be the same providers of CEs.

The Committee accepted Ms. Smith's proposal for assistance in creating a comprehensive list.

Conferences/Seminars/Meetings

NLC Cohort Meeting, September 22, 2016, Rosemont, Illinois – EO

The EO provided a written report to the Board. The EO commented that the meeting was for a few states who were considering submitting legislation in 2017 to join the Nurse Licensure Compact ("NLC"). Apparently NCSBN is under the impression that Hawaii will be submitting legislation in 2017 to join the "enhanced" compact ("eNLC"). Recommendations and resources were provided on how to

proceed with legislation to adopt the eNLC. Although the Hawaii Board of Nursing is in general support to join the eNLC, there are concerns on the negative fiscal impact it would have on the department/division and not knowing how many nurses are actually practicing in the State.

Regulation 2030 Meeting, October 2-3, 2016, Chicago, Illinois

The EO stated the Chair will report on this at the Board's November meeting.

International Nurse Regulator Collaborative Symposium, October 4-5, 2016, Chicago, Illinois

Ms. Napoleon provided a written report to the Board. Ms. Napoleon commented that she really enjoyed the meeting. Hawaii State
Center for Nursing:

“Advanced-practice nurse ranks grow” – Star Advertiser

The Board reviewed an article from the Star Advertiser about how the number of active advanced practice registered nurses in Hawaii who provide primary care has nearly doubled since 2005 as the state continues to face a shortage of doctors.

Ms. Reichhardt, Director of the Center for Nursing is quoted in the article as stating, “Absolutely the increased numbers of APRNs in the state are contributing to the primary care workforce. They’re working in ambulatory care, in physicians’ offices and community health centers”.

Correspondence:

Does an RN need a Doctor’s order to start an IV and giving IV vitamins pursuant to a Naturopath?

The Board reviewed an email inquiry asking if an RN needs doctor’s orders for starting an IV and giving IV vitamins and can the order be given by a Naturopathic physician.

The EO stated in Chapter 457-2 under Definitions it states that a registered nurse may carry out the prescribed medical orders of a licensed dentist, physician, osteopathic physician, advanced practice registered nurse, physician assistant or podiatrist. A Naturopathic Physician is not included in the definition.

Mr. Joslyn stated if Naturopathic physician is not included, then it is not allowed.

After a brief discussion and review of the laws and rules, the Board by consensus determined that an RN can start an IV and give IV vitamins pursuant to a physician's order. However, pursuant to 457-2 under Definitions, a Naturopathic Physician is not included in the definition and therefore an RN may not start an IV pursuant to an order by a Naturopathic Physician.
