Amendments to HAR Chapter 89

The EO stated any of the following that can be amended in HAR Chapter 89 she is working on putting into the draft.

- Distance/Online Prelicensure Nursing Programs -The Committee will use draft provided at the January 8, 2015 meeting as a reference:
- Temporary License of MEPN Students -May require a law and/or rule amendment to issue only a temporary license to MEPN students;
- National Accreditation and/or Board Approved Nursing Programs;
- Foreign Educated English Proficiency MELAB Examination –
 Consideration for Waiver of English Proficiency Exam if Foreign Nursing
 Program was Taught in English;
- Limiting the Number of Times Exam Candidate Allowed to Take NCLEX-In proposed rule revisions; in proposed rule revisions;
- Annual Pass Rate: 90% of National Pass Rate (NPR) vs. No Percentage of NPR;
- Probation of Hawaii Nursing Programs for Non-Compliance of Nursing Laws/Rules and/or Pass Rate Below National Standards; and
- Ratios Ratio allowed for direct supervision of students.

The EO asked for volunteers to work on researching SARA.

Dr. Fleming and Ms. Daub volunteered to do research on SARA.

Continuing Competency:

Joanna Smith – Potential Challenges with Monitoring Mandatory Continuing Education – Possible Solutions

The EO stated she did provide the Board of Nursing with a copy of Ms. Smith's report. With all this information Ms. Smith provided it will make it easier to come out with a list. The EO wants to have something available to show the Board at its December meeting.

Dr. Fleming asked, once we have an approved list, will we then post it on the Board's webpage?

The EO replied yes. However, she does not want to put too much information on the webpage all at once, so she will start by disseminating the information to employers. She is afraid that if she puts too much information out now about continued competency, licensees will mistakenly think this is for the June 30, 2017 renewal.

Ms. Reichhardt suggested creating a slogan for the 2019 renewal, so licensees will know and understand that this is effective starting July 1, 2017 and due by June 30, 2019. Ms. Reichhardt asked if the information provided by Ms. Smith is only on continuing education ("CE") or does it provide information on all the learning activity options?

The EO stated there is information other than CE's, but that is something the Board will have to look at on a case by case basis. I don't think we could do a list of approved agencies for other than CE's.

Ms. Reichhardt stated she has some information from HSCFN's partners that she would like to provide also.

The EO stated she would gladly take that information and see if she can incorporate it. A question was asked if ACLS or PALS/BLS courses would be acceptable towards CE's.

Ms. Napoleon stated completing those courses is part of your job.

The EO stated she is not sure if those would count then.

Ms. Napoleon asked what if you became a BLS instructor?

Dr. Fleming stated that may not be a part of your job, being an instructor, but what if you are faculty? Does being faculty make you exempt from doing CE's?

Ms. Reichhardt stated just being a faculty member would not qualify, but if there is that item that says "updating curriculum" or "developing new curriculum", then maybe.

Dr. Fleming stated that is something that would have to be reviewed by the Board.

The EO stated she does not want the Board reviewing individual courses. The Board can come up with criteria that has to be met, and that it be through an approved accrediting provider, etc.

Ms. Reichhardt stated it has be development and presentation of a course.

The EO stated the Committee needs to come up with criteria to present to the Board.
