EXEMPTION FROM CHAPTER 444, HRS

OWNER-BUILDER SELLING PROPERTY WITHIN ONE YEAR OF COMPLETION

Instructions for Filing

Section 444-2.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, allows owner-builders to request an exemption from the prohibition on selling their property within a year of completion due to an eligible unforeseen hardship.

To request a determination on the eligibility of an unforeseen hardship, complete the application form and submit the form and supporting documentation detailing the hardship to:

Supporting documentation may include evidence of receipt of unemployment compensation, tax returns, medical records, bank statements, divorce decrees ordering the sale of property, mortgage default letters, and bankruptcy filings.

The Contractors License Board shall respond to your request in writing within 90 days of receiving the completed application.
