Executive Officer's
Report:

a. Exams

The Executive Officer informed the Board that the exam development has stopped since Dawn Kubota left and that a new company, PROV is willing to develop the exams with no up-front costs provided all Professional Vocational Licensing ("PVL") exams are transferred to them. PVL is seeking procurement training to determine the feasibility and whether this can be done. Many testing vendors want the larger exams, but are not willing to take on the smaller exams like the Private Detective and Guard exams.

b. Renewals

Online renewals for guards, guard agencies, private detectives, private detective agencies and guard employees were available on May 9, 2016. A random audit for the guard employees will be administered after the renewal period requesting the certificates for proof of attending a requisite 4 hour continuing education course.

c. Guard Employee Online Registration

The Executive Officer informed the Board that guard employees may now submit their applications online. While it must still be manually reviewed, it should speed up the process. Email responses will be automatically generated regarding the status of their application which should lessen the phone call volume. Any documents uploaded will still need to be reviewed, however there will be less chance of lost documents.

Relating to its
Implementation:

a. Initial 8 Hour Security Guard Training Curricula

- 1) Classroom Definition (Deferred from the January 14, 2016 meeting.)

Mr. Denis suggested soliciting input from retail companies, hotels, guard agencies, third party trainers, hospitals, etc.

After some discussion, it was moved by Mr. Chang, seconded by Chief Kubojiri and unanimously carried to establish an Ad Hoc committee to discuss guidelines and standards for Distance Learning subject to approval by the Board. Chairperson Inouye appointed Mr. Denis and Mr. Chang and charged them with establishing an eight member ad hoc committee that should meet prior to the Board's next meeting. At that time Mr. Denis and Mr. Chang will report their findings and provide the Committee's recommendations for the Board's consideration.

- b. Email inquiry regarding guard cards for police officers. (Deferred from the March 10, 2016 meeting.)

The Executive Officer stated that the GDE must be an employee and that HRS chapter 436B-2 defines "License" as a registration:

§436B-2 General definitions. As used in this chapter:.....

“License” means the permission to engage in a profession or vocation granted by the applicable licensing authority to a person who has satisfied every requirement for licensure, and shall include any registration, certificate, or other document issued by the licensing authority reflecting proof of permission.....

DAG Tam added that HAR chapter 16-97-8(b) states that ...”a reserve officer of any law enforcement agency shall not maintain or be eligible for any license issued under chapter 463, HRS.” The Executive Officer noted that HAR chapter 16-97-8(b) referred to a Private Detective and Guard license and that it is clearly a conflict for a current law enforcement officer to act as a principal. However, as a guard employee, this person is an employee. They do not have a “license” to offer to provide guard or detective services. Thus in this instance “registration” is not equivalent to a license in HRS chapter 463.

She also noted prior Board decisions where the Board opined that registration under Act 208 was not required because active law enforcement officers were exempt.

Chief Kubojiri and Chief Perry added that Hawaii and Kauai counties do not allow moonlighting. Chief Kubojiri explained that an officer can be disciplined for any off-duty conduct and cannot double dip. Because they have police powers 24/7, it is difficult to determine liability. Hence their disallowance of any officer working in the security industry.

It was moved by Mr. Chang, seconded by Mr. Denis, and unanimously carried to defer the email inquiry regarding guard employee registration cards for police officers for further research by DAG Tam and discussion with the Attorney General’s office.
