c. <u>Hawaii Administrative Rules ("HAR") Proposed</u> Amendments - Update Real Estate Appraiser Advisory Committee Minutes of the October 5, 2016 Meeting Page 4

Executive Officer Taniguchi provided an update to the proposed amendments to HAR chapter 16-114, to codify the state's regulations on supervisory and trainee appraisers to comply with AQB Criteria requirements. He stated the Governor has provided his final approval (last week) for adoption of the rules, and those rules are currently at the Office of the Lieutenant Governor for filing.

# Unfinished Business:

Discussion ensued on the Committee's formal recommendation to Director Awakuni Colón who had requested for the Committee to propose a formal recommendation regarding the level of regulation that should be implemented based on the context of Hawaii's current and future real estate appraisal needs on the new federal requirements relating to the minimum requirements for Appraisal Management Companies ("AMCs"). Chairperson Stellmacher thanked Ms. Tanaka for her work with the Hawaii Chapter of the Appraisal Institute in conducting a survey that was emailed to about 300 real estate appraisers and affiliates for their comments/ concerns regarding the regulation of AMCs. A total of 49 responses were received. A third of the respondents did not do any work for AMCs; only 8 said AMCs accounted for 50% or more of their assignments. Chairperson Stellmacher stated that comments included low appraisal fees and slow payment times and that respondents primarily were concerned with "protection from the ills of business".

The Committee pointed out that AMC regulation is not mandated, and there would not be any penalties for implementing regulation at a later date. Therefore, considering the projected cost to implement an AMC regulatory framework, and lack of overwhelming support in favor of regulation, the Committee recommends to Director Awakuni Colón to defer AMC regulation at this time.
