- Agenda: The agenda for this meeting was filed with the Office of the Lieutenant Governor, as required by Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") section 92-7(b).
- Call to Order: There being a quorum present, the meeting was called to order at 1:04 p.m. by Chairperson McKay.
- Deputy Attorney General ("DAG") Krishna F. Jayaram was introduced to the Board. DAG Jayaram briefly mentioned to the Board that he had been with Corporation Counsel for the City and County of Honolulu for the last seven (7) years.
- Ms. Williams arrived to the meeting at 1:05 p.m.
- Minutes of the August 17, 2017 Board Meeting: After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Nelson, seconded by Mr. Choi, and unanimously carried to approve the minutes of the August 17, 2017 Board meeting, as circulated.

At 1:06 p.m., it was moved by Mr. Choi, seconded by Ms. Tokunaga, and unanimously carried for the Board to enter into Executive Session to consider and evaluate personal information relating to individuals applying for licensure in accordance with HRS section 92-5(a)(1), and to consult with the Board's attorney on questions and issues pertaining to the Board's powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities in accordance with HRS section 92-5(a)(4).

She noted that the meeting dates are the third Mondays of the month with the exception of January and February (being that the third Mondays fall on a holiday). B. Proposed Amendments to Hawaii Administrative Rules Chapter 16-73 (Barbering)

Executive Officer Kai asked about the status of the rule revisions. Committee members Ms. Williams and Mr. Nelson, responded that the work is ongoing.

C. Proposed Amendments to Hawaii Administrative Rules Chapter 16-78 (Cosmetology)

Executive Officer Kai stated that she received the voluminous rule revisions from the Investigative Committee and

incorporating the revisions into the chapter is not yet complete. Upon completion, the Investigative Committee will present the proposed amendments to the full Board for discussion and consideration.

Educational Sessions Held in Licensed Shops for Licensed Beauty Operators And Barbers:

DAG Jayaram requested that the Board table this agenda item to allow more time for him to research this matter. It was noted that this matter had been previously requested to temporarily assigned DAGs to this Board to conduct further research on whether HRS section 439-2 (b) and Hawaii Administrative Rules ("HAR") sections 16-78-36(6) and 16-78-37(5), or any other statutes or administrative rules were pertinent to the matter under consideration by the Board. It was reiterated that the issue had been initiated by occurrences in the professional community where licensed beauty operators without Hawaii instructor licenses were conducting educational sessions that are designed and offered to licensed beauty operators and barbers and held in licensed shops. The licensed beauty operators and barbers are typically charged a fee for the instructional session(s). Mr. Choi also requested that DAG Jayaram also take into consideration situations where out of State "educators" or "instructors" representing a particular product or service would be allowed to trade training for the anticipated purchase of the products or services.

The Board's consensus was to table this agenda item to the next Board meeting in order to provide DAG Jayaram time to conduct further research.
