Correspondence: A. June 9, 2016 email from Dagian A. Velazquez-Carpenter  
Re: Chiropractor Scope of Practice Question.

The Board reviewed and discussed Dagian A. Velazquez-Carpenter's email dated June 9, 2016, regarding whether ordering toxicology and genetics screening tests fall within the scope of practice for a chiropractor.

DAG Jacob referred to the Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") §442-1, which set forth the scope of practice for Chiropractic licensees.

Dr. Redmond stated that medicine is changing dramatically for the rich only because most major insurance carriers will not pay for genetic screening services.

Dr. Redmond explained that you can now tailor make medicine for your specific need. Dr. Redmond went on to say that you can get genetic marker for a patient. But to order outside of the norm, one would need approval.

After due consideration of Ms. Velazquez-Carpenter's email, it was moved by Dr. Klein, seconded by Dr. Pleiss, and unanimously carried that toxicology and genetics screening tests fall within the scope of practice for a chiropractic. It was suggested to have the Executive Officer Bhanot provide an informal, non-binding opinion referring to the HRS §442-1 and section 16-76-26(5), HAR, which set forth the scope of practice for Chiropractic licensees.

Additionally, the Board suggested that Ms. Velazquez-Carpenter seek private legal counsel for any further guidance or assistance in interpreting these statutes.
