<u>Correspondence:</u> A. <u>October 17, 2016 email from Shelly Kasprick, D.C.</u> <u>Re: Sports Physicals</u>

The Board reviewed and discussed the email dated October 17, 2016 from Shelly Kasprick, D.C.

Dr. Kasprick's email asks "Can chiropractors in Hawaii performs school sports physicals?"

After due consideration, the Board reference the Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS) Chapter 442 and Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR) Chapter 76 do not specifically address performing school sports physicals.

Additionally, the Board referred to HRS §442-1 and HAR §16-76-25 and §16-76-26(2) for the scope of practice of chiropractic and minimal acceptable clinical competencies necessary to the practice of chiropractic.

Dr. Kasprick's email also asked "Does the license encompass the definition of "physician"?" The Board references the following citation to the HRS which set forth the title for Chiropractor licensees.

§442-19 Violations, penalty. Any person who practices or attempts to practice chiropractic, or any person who buys, sells, or fraudulently obtains a license to practice chiropractic, whether recorded or not, or who uses the title "chiropractor" or "D.C.", or any word or title to induce, or tending to induce belief that the person is engaged in the practice of chiropractic, without first complying with this chapter; or any licensee under this chapter Board of Chiropractic Examiners - Minutes November 3, 2016 Page 4

> who uses the word "doctor" or the prefix "Dr." without the word "chiropractor" or "D.C." immediately following the licensee's name, or uses the letters "M.D." or the words "doctor of medicine", or the term "surgeon", or the term "physician", or the word "osteopath", or the letters "D.O.", or any other letters, prefixes, or suffixes, the use of which would indicate that the licensee is practicing a profession for which the licensee holds no license from the State, or any person who violates any of the provisions of this chapter, shall be fined not more than \$1,000, or imprisoned not more than ninety days, or both.
