Legislation:

A. Senate Bill No. 191, Relating to Health Care Practitioner Transparency

The Board discussed the above bill relating to Health Care Practitioner Transparency.

The purpose of the bill is to require the health care practitioner to wear a photo identification name tag during patient encounters that shall include; a recent photograph of the practitioner; the practitioner's name; the type of license; and the expiration date of the license. The name tag shall be of sufficient size and worn in a conspicuous manner so as to be visible and apparent. Additionally, the health practitioners is to display in the practitioner's office a writing that clearly identifies the type of license held.

Discussion followed. The Board determined that it would take no position on this matter.
