<u>Call to Order</u>: There being a quorum present, Chairperson Polischeck called the meeting to

order at 8:30 a.m.

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Chairperson Polischeck announced that this was the last meeting for Messers. Kamai and Mochida, who both served two terms (eight years) on the Board. The Board and staff expressed their appreciation for their invaluable service.

Agenda:

The agenda for this meeting was filed with the Office of the Lieutenant Governor, as required by Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") section 92-7(b).

Minutes:

It was moved by Mr. Lee, seconded by Mr. Konishi, and unanimously carried to approve the Applications Committee Meeting and Executive Session Meeting minutes of June 5, 2017, and the Board Meeting Minutes and Executive Session Meeting Minutes of May 12, 2017, as circulated.

Chapter 91, HRS, Adjudicatory Matters:

Chairperson Polischeck called for a recess from the Board's meeting at 8:37 a.m. to discuss and deliberate on the following adjudicatory matters pursuant to HRS chapter 91.

- 1. Settlement Agreements
- a. <u>In the Matter of the Contractor's Licenses of Fediuk Homes, Inc., dba</u> Island Paradise Homes, and David S. Fediuk; CLB 2016-444-L

Respondents Fediuk Homes, Inc. ("Respondent Fediuk Homes") and David S. Fediuk ("Respondent Fediuk") are licensed under license numbers CT-25018 and CT-25019, respectively. Respondents licenses were issued on or about March 19, 2004; and will expire or forfeit on or about September 30, 2018. At all relevant times herein, Respondent Fediuk was the responsible managing employee for Respondent Fediuk Homes.

Respondent Fediuk Homes received a Citation and Notification of Penalty on February 25, 2015 in Inspection Number: 1017925 by the Hawaii Occupational Safety and Health Division. The February 25, 2015 Citation was based on

allegations Respondent Fediuk Homes, among other things, failed to ensure subcontractors utilized conventional fall prevention while installing roof sheathing and imposed a \$1,650.00 penalty. The penalty was paid in full.

RICO alleges Respondents violated applicable safety laws. If proven at an administrative hearing, the allegations would constitute violations of the following statute:

• HRS section 444-17(6) (violation of applicable safety or labor low).

Respondents do not admit to violating any law or rule, and agree to pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$100.00.

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Isemoto, seconded by Mr. Konishi, and unanimously carried to approve the Settlement Agreement Prior to Filing of Petition for Disciplinary Action and Board's Final Order in the above case.

2. <u>Board's Final Orders</u>

None.

Following the Board's review, deliberation and decisions in these matters, pursuant to HRS chapter 91, Chairperson Polischeck announced that the Board was reconvening to its open meeting at 8:48 a.m.

Committee Reports:

- 1. <u>Scope of Activity Committee</u> Nathan T. Konishi, Chairperson
- a. **Digital Alarm Technology Inc.** Requests a confirmation that license C31540 is sufficient enough for installing wireless alarm systems. We install wireless Honeywell security alarm systems, all systems are wireless, no hardwire. We only plug in the control panel (like plugging in a toaster).
 - Mr. Sal Sorbera, Digital Alarm Technology, Inc. ("DAT") stated that DAT currently has a C-15b Telecommunications contractor's license. He also stated that Dennis Tomasu, RME is currently applying for the C-15 Electronic systems classification.
 - Mr. Pat Borges, Sales Representative for DAT brought the Honeywell LYNX Touch L5210 control panel that DAT installs for the Board to examine. He stated that a C-15 Electronic systems contractor's license is not required to install this system because it does not require any hard wiring, everything to the transformer is 9 volts, and the control panel is plugged into an existing electrical outlet.
 - Mr. Borges added that the Honeywell LYNX Touch L5210 series security system ("L5210 system") has a built in cell card which calls the monitoring company and the homeowner; the siren is built in the control

panel and there is no siren outside the home; and all window and door sensors operate on lithium batteries. The installation of the L5210 System is strictly residential and must be installed by a DAT technician; this system cannot be bought off the shelf and installed by the homeowner.

Mr. Russell Lum, Senior Security Consultant for DAT stated that the Board determined at its April 21, 2011 meeting that if an alarm system is totally wireless and does not require any actual hard wiring to install the system, a contractor's license is not required. He also stated that the Board of Electricians and Plumbers determined that a journeyman electrician license is not required to install the system since it is wireless. He understands that there are other alarm systems that require hard wiring for the installation and a C-15 Electronic systems or C-15a Fire and burglar alarm contractor's license and a licensed electrician would be required for the installation. However, the L5210 System is totally wireless and going by the Board's April 21, 2011 determination, a contractor's license is not required. He added that DAT is requesting a determination from the Board because a competitor notified their monitoring company that DAT needs a C-15a contractor's license to install alarms. The monitoring company is asking for a letter from the Board stating that DAT may install the alarm system with its C-15b contractor's license.

b. Coating Works Hawaii, Inc. (deferred from May 12, 2017 meeting) – Requests a determination whether a C-43a Reconditioning and repairing pipeline contractor may apply plural - component, chemical resistant epoxy coating, to new and/or existing sewer manholes, wet wells or any other sewer structure requiring protective coating against biogenic sulfide corrosion.

Mr. Alberto Doncos, Painters Union, stated that this work falls under the C-33 Painting and decorating contractor's license.

The Board asked Mr. Doncos how the epoxy coating is applied. He stated that the surface if prepared by sandblasting or pressure washing (2000 psi). The epoxy coating is sprayed, troweled or rolled on the surface.

c. **Nether Industries Inc.** – Requests a clarification on the Board's April 13, 2017 determination that the installation of process equipment at Big Island Dairy requires the C-37 Plumbing contractor's license; C-52 Ventilating and air conditioning or C-40 Refrigeration contractor's license (depending on the temperature of the glycol); C-4 Boiler, hot-water heating, hot water supply, and steam fitting contractor's license; and a C-56 Welding contractor's license is required if the welding performed is not related to the C-4 classification work.

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Executive Session:

At 9:04 a.m., it was moved by Mr. Lee, seconded by Mr. Isemoto, and unanimously carried to enter into executive session pursuant to HRS section 92-5(a)(4) to consult with James C. Paige, deputy attorney general, on questions and issues pertaining to the Board's powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities regarding some of the applicants.

At 9:17 a.m., it was moved by Mr. Lee, seconded by Mr. Isemoto, and unanimously carried to move out of executive session and to reconvene to the Board's regular order of business.

Digital Alarm Technology Inc.

The Board asked DAT what procedures they perform after the control panel is taken out of its box. Mr. Borges stated that the red spade is attached to the red terminal in the control panel and the black spade is attached to the black terminal in the control panel. Sometimes the power wire is extended to reach the outlet. The L5210 System must be installed by a DAT technician because even though the spade and terminal are color coded, there is a chance that it may be installed incorrectly.

Executive Session:

At 9:21 a.m., it was moved by Mr. Lee, seconded by Mr. Kagawa, and unanimously carried to enter into executive session pursuant to HRS section 92-5(a)(4) to consult with James C. Paige, deputy attorney general, on questions and issues pertaining to the Board's powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities regarding some of the applicants.

At 9:35 a.m., it was moved by Mr. Konishi, seconded by Mr. Lee, and unanimously carried to move out of executive session and to reconvene to the Board's regular order of business.

a. Digital Alarm Technology Inc.

Recommendation: DAT cannot install the Honeywell LYNX Touch L5210 series security system with its C-15b Telecommunications contractor's license; and the C-13 Electronic, C-15 Electronic systems, or C-15a Fire and burglar alarm contractor's license is required to install the Honeywell LYNX Touch L5210 Series Security System.

Mr. Borges stated that the L5210 System is the same system that is described in the Board's determination at its April 21, 2011 meeting, and felt that the Board should be consistent with its past determination.

The Board stated that based on the information provided by DAT on the L5210 System, wire connections inside the control panel are required, wire connections to the transformer are required, the extension of the power supply wire is sometimes required to install the L5210 System, and the manual for the installation of the L5210 System contains wiring instructions. Mr. Tomasu stated for clarification: a contractor's license is

not required only if the manufacturer pre-wires (factory pre-wired) the system, and the system is taken out of its box and plugged into an electrical outlet. The Board stated that Mr. Tomasu's statement is correct because what he described does not require any hard wiring. The Board also recommended that DAT check with the Board of Electricians and Plumbers whether a licensed electrician is required.

b. Coating Works Hawaii, Inc. (deferred from May 12, 2017 meeting) –

This matter remains deferred until the additional information requested by the Board at its May 12, 2017 meeting is provided.

No Board action as Mr. Sanders has not communicated the clarification that he is requesting.
