## Old Business: a. Rules Committee Report

At the last meeting, the Committee was informed that at the June NCARB Annual Meeting, membership voted to change the name of the Intern Development Program ("IDP") to Architectural Experience Program ("AXP"). Therefore, the Committee recommended that all references to IDP be replaced with AXP in the rules.

Regarding section 16-115-31(b)(2) and (3), HAR, Mr. Kobashigawa informed the Committee that the current provision requires verification of lawful experience and verification of experience in responsible charge to be completed by a supervisor in the same discipline of engineering applying for when applying for the Fundamentals of Engineering ("FE") examination.

However for the FE examination, the applicant is not applying for a specific discipline of engineering and only engineering experience is required. It is not dependent on the experience being in a particular discipline of engineering.

After discussion, by consensus, the Committee recommended amending the requirement to only require engineering experience and not require that the verification be completed by a supervisor in the same discipline of engineering.

Moreover, Mr. Yumol and Mr. Kobashigawa will be meeting separately to discuss which provisions should be advanced for approval and public hearing, and which provisions will be deferred to continue discussions.

It was moved by Mr. Iwamoto, seconded by Mr. Pang, and unanimously carried to approve the July 14, 2016 Rules Committee Meeting minutes.

For those who are currently taking A.R.E. 4.0 and want to transition to 5.0, they can self-transition their eligibilities after logging into *My NCARB* once 5.0 has launched. For candidates who want to take the 4.0 version, they'll need to request eligibility through *My NCARB* by October 31, 2016.
